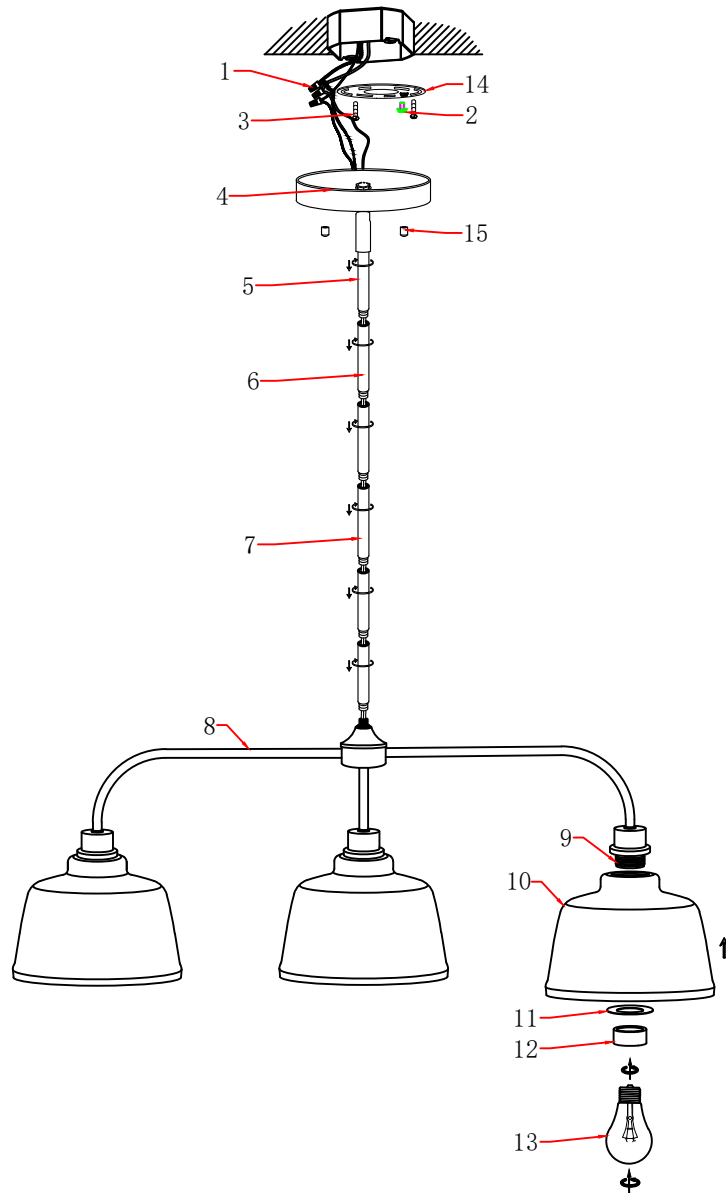


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

Step A: Attach the suspension rods (5)(6)(7) onto the fixture body (8) by twisting clockwise until fully seated.

Step B: Secure the mounting plate (14) onto the junction box using screw (3).

Step C: Connect the canopy (4) to the suspension rod.

Step D:

· Connect the positive main wire (marked with text) to the positive power supply wire (+) with wire connector (1).

· Similarly, connect the negative main wire (unmarked) to the negative power supply wire (-) with a wire connector (1).

Notice: Ensure no bare wires are exposed to prevent electrical leakage.

· Secure the fixture ground wire and external ground wire to the mounting plate (14) with the green screw (2).

Step E: Lift the canopy (4) up to the ceiling and secure it using decorative screws (15).

Step F: Align the holes in the glass shade (10) with the lamp holder (9). Place the circular metal plate (11) over the lamp holder, and then tighten the locking ring (12).

Step G: Install bulb (13) (not included) firmly into the socket (9).

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
