
CEILING FAN with LIGHTING KITS



Owner's Manual Read And Save These Instructions

Safety Precaution

IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ BEFORE INSTALLATION

- 1. Installation must be carried out by a qualified wiring installer.
- 2. Turn off the electrical mains at the circuit breaker fuse box.
- 3. When mounting the fan, ensure that the safety cable is loop across the ceiling mounting hook.
- 4. The ceiling mounting hook must be able to with hold a min of 70 pounds.
- 5. Do not install the appliance less than 2.3M from the ground and 1M from the wall to the blades.
- 6. Do not place any objects in the path of the blades.
- 7. When all electrical connections are done, store all wires neatly.
- 8. Make sure that all screws and connection are tightly screwed and secure.



If there is no exsiting mounting box, then read the following instructions. Disconnect the power by removing the fuses or by turning off the circuit breakers

Secured the outlet box directly to the building structure. Use appropriate fasteners and building materials. The outlet box and its support must be able to fully support the moving weight of the fan(at least 70 lbs). Do not use plastic outlet boxes.


1. Hanger Options

To avoid possible electrical shock, before installing your fan, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breakers to the outlet box associated with the Wall switch location.




1A. Installing the Mounting bracket

1, For the Concrete Ceiling:Mark the location for the ceiling fan first, then drill two holes in the ceiling to aid in securing ceiling bracket with two expansion screws provided, and secure the mounting bracket to the building structure with two expansion screws provided, tighten the screws. (Fig. 1)




1B. Installing the Mounting bracket

 For the Wood Ceiling: Mark the location for the ceiling fan first secure the mounting bracket to the building structure with four wood screws and washer provided. (Fig. 2)




2. Hanging Motor houing

1. Lift the Motor housing and hang it on the hook of the mounting bracket. (Fig. 3)




3. Wiring

1. Wiring according to the wiring diagram. (Fig. 4)




4. The receiver installation

1, Put the receiver in the Motor housing after the wire is connected. (Fig. 5)




5. Installing Motor housing

- 5.1 Remove two mounting bracket screws. (Fig. 6-1)
- 5.2 Remove the motor housing from the hook and align it with the mounting bracket hole on the suspension plate, push up and turn Clockwise. (Fig. 6-2 1) 2)
- 5.3 tighten the four mounting bracket screws. (Fig. 6-3)




6. Blade assembly installation

- 1. Remove blade iron screws from fan motor. (Fig. 7)
- 2. Attach the blade to the motor with blade iron screws. (Fig. 7)
- 3. Repeat this step for each blade assembly. (Fig. 7)




7. Install on light kits


- 7.1, Feed the wire through the center hole of the lamp base. (Fig. 9)
- 7.2, Fix the lamp base with screws, then connect wire with motor by Wiring cap. then put on the light kit by magnet. (fig. 8 and 9)



8. The lampshade installation

8.1, Install the lampshade to the lamp base by turning clockwise to lock it into place. (Fig. 10)
