- This fire bowl is intended to burn wood logs only. Do not burn coal, leaves, or other combustible materials in the fire bowl.
- Not for use by children. Keep children and pets away from the fire bowl.
- The fire bowl is hot. Use with caution. Do not touch the hot fire bowl with bare hands.
- Never leave the burning fire bowl unattended, and always extinguish the fire completely before leaving the fire bowl.
- Do not use near flammable or combustible objects or materials.
- When the fire bowl is in use, the handle on the mesh screen can reach extreme temperatures that can cause serious injury to an unprotected hand. Use a poker or an appropriate heat resistant glove or pad when handling.
- Check local fire regulations and municipal by-laws for safe use.

Assembly Procedures:



TOOLS REQUIRED (Not included)

Step By Step Assembly Instructions:

- Step1: Insert the handle(A) into the hole on the top of the mesh cover (B).
- Attach the handle (A)to the mesh cover (B) using a nut(BB),Securely tighten with an M6 wrench (not included)



Step 2: Attach the Legs (E) to the Fire bowl (D) by using 8pcs M6 x 18 mm bolts (AA). Note: Tighten all the bolts.





Step 3: Placed the cooking grill(C), wood grate (D), mesh cover in the fire bowl. Now,enjoy your fire pit.





Lighting Instructions:

CAUTION: Do NOT add gasoline, kerosene, diesel fuel, lighter fluid or alcohol to relight or enhance an existing fire.

Extinguishing:

1. Allow fire to burn itself out.

Storage:

2. Do NOT use water to extinguish as this is dangerous and can cause damage to the outdoor fire pit.



Care and Cleaning:

- Do not attempt to clean the fire pit until the fire is completely out and cooled completely.
- Use a soft cloth to wipe the fire pit and poker.
- Do not attempt to clean while hot.



- Do not attempt to move the fire pit while it is hot or in use.
- Store assembled in a cool, dry location away from children and pets.
- Keep the fire pit covered when cooled and not in use
