Dutch Iris hybrids grow from bulbs that can be planted in fall or spring and are often grown as annuals. These graceful and elegant flowers bloom atop grass-like foliage. They are easy to grow, and if zone appropriate, are great for naturalizing. They are often used as cut flowers.

*About This Variety:* Miss Saigon Iris produce wonderful spring colored blooms, perfect for Easter bouquets and nearly any garden.

*Growing Instructions:* Choose a site that has reasonably fertile soil and plenty of moisture that won't dry out in summer. Good drainage and a sheltered location will help them survive the winter.

*Care Tip:* Plant about 15 bulbs per square foot. Zone 5 gardeners should add a 2" layer of mulch in fall. Best planted in large numbers.

*Exposure:* Full sun to partial shade

*Height:* Grows 20" tall

*Spacing:* Plant 4" apart, 5" deep

*USDA Zones:* Hardy in USDA zones 6-8
