WILD HOG SCRAM

EASY TO APPLY INSTRUCTIONS

Wild Hog Scram™ is a proprietary blend of natural and biodegradable ingredients specifically designed to reduce and eliminate wild hog activity. Repels wild hogs and alters their digestive system in two ways: Food tastes bad and their digestive system is disturbed, and surrounding soil become bad smelling.

Until recently, ranges of wild hogs (a.k.a. feral pigs) were restricted to the southern states. Today, as many as 5 million feral pigs roam the U.S.A. due to several factors: having no natural predators, an abundance of food, and they are able to adapt & reproduce quickly.

BEFORE APPLYING Wild Hog Scram™ granular repellent; carefully examine your property. Besides the visible damage in your lawn & beds look in garden plots and gardens. **Locate entry trails** if possible as this will ensure you are targeting the problem correctly.

FOR BEST RESULTS, SET YOUR SPREADER SETTING TO 60% OPEN.

Each spreader has holes that dispense product. Because of the variety of spreader styles - look at your spreader's holes' open & close. Typically left is lowest & right is wide open. Middle point is 50%. You may need to adjust for proper coverage as spreader conditions, rate of walk are just some of the variables that can affect the rate of application.

Cover the area where wild hog damage has been observed and/or is occurring. Extend the coverage to about thirty (30) feet around and beyond the damaged area. For lawn and garden areas of 5,000 or less square feet, we recommend covering the entire area.



Hand sprinkle, using the scoop provided, within damaged garden plots and beds.

If possible, **locate entry trails**. Apply in a band across the trail where it enters an area to be protected. Also, apply on the trail for 30 feet back from the starting entrance using a 4-foot wide band.

Reapply Wild Hog Scram in 14 days after the initial application and then every 30 days or as needed. Extremely heavy rain may require re-application.



SAFETY TIPS REGARDING WILD HOGS: Invasive hogs can be **aggressive**, especially when defending their young. **BE ALERT!** Know the signs & tracks of hogs and avoid heavily used areas, especially at dusk or dawn when hogs are most active. **Avoid** water sources used by hogs - humans can contract multiple diseases from water sources contaminated by hogs and their feces.
