Oxalis Versicolor is a fully hardy perennial evergreen subshrub. Sometimes referred to as Grand Duchess Versicolor, the leaves are clover-like and green in color. The red and white spiral shaped trumpet flowers appear in summer. Buds twist open in a spiral fashion in the morning.
