

What is squaring?

Squaring is the process of ensuring that your project is accurately aligned and measures equally from corner to corner. For reference, the equal measurements for each of the four corners should be 90 degrees.

- Why is squaring important for your wood closet tower?
 - Prevents the wood closet tower from being uneven
 - Ensures that wood closet drawers fit properly
 - Ensures that wood closet doors fit properly
 - Helps to prevent sagging over time

COMMON METHODS OF SQUARING:



SQUARING TOOL

Use a squaring tool to verify that your tower shelving is perpendicular to the sides. This will help to ensure the tower is square.



CLAMPING TOOL

A clamping square will help to align the tops and sides of the towers at a 90 degree angle. This will help to ensure the tower is square.



TAPE MEASURE

Measure the diagonal length from corner to corner. This length should equal the measurement of the opposite corners. This will help to ensure the tower is square.
