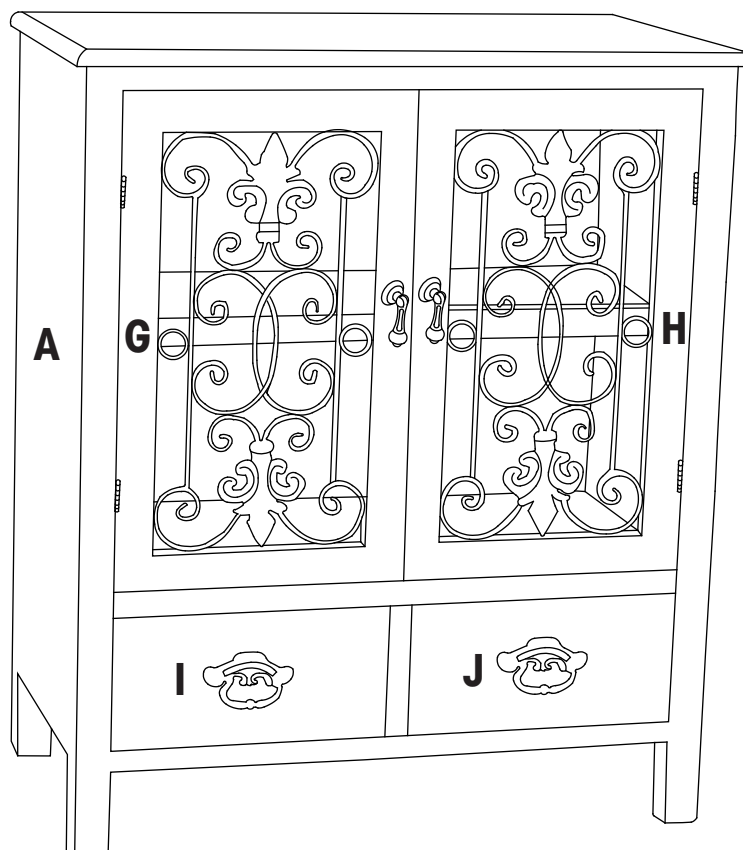

DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN SCREWS AND BOLTS.

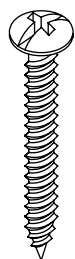

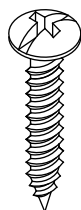
- (A) CONSOLE

- (J) RIGHT DRAWER



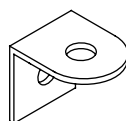

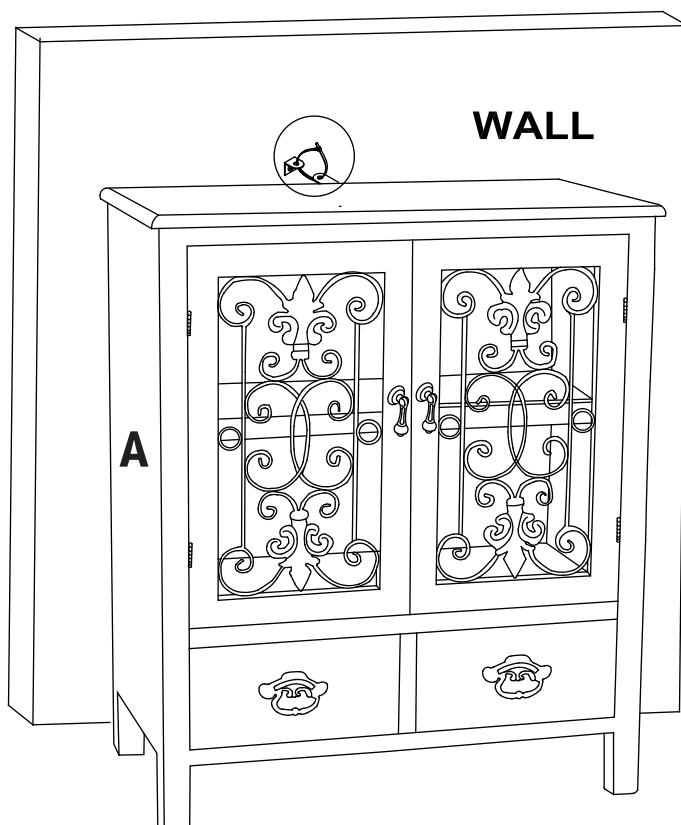
TO PREVENT TIP OVER, THE PRODUCT MUST BE ATTACHED TO WALL.
