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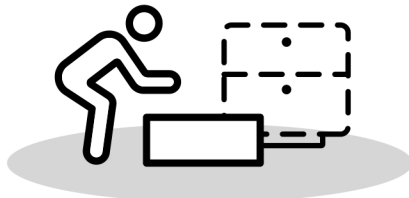
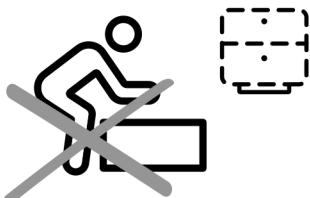
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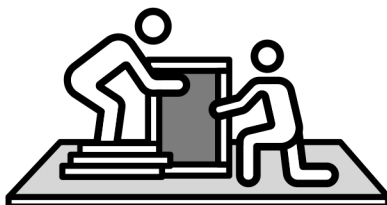
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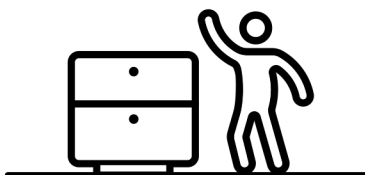
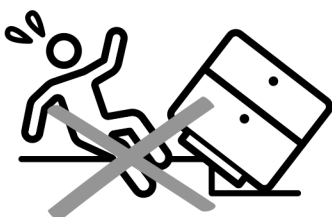
Sufficient Space

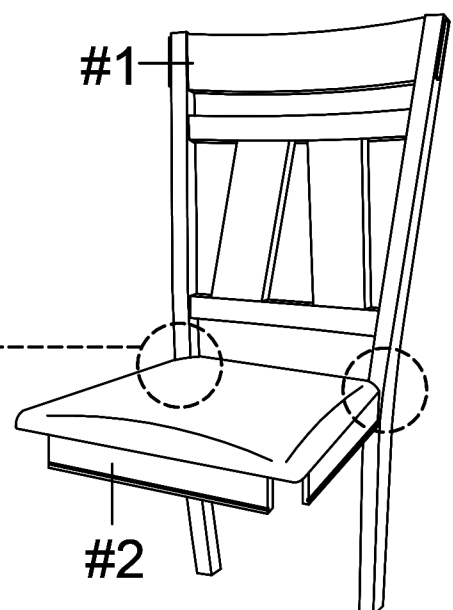
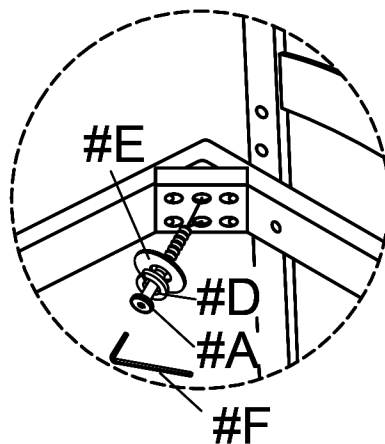


Insert dowel (#G) to the chair back (#1), then align seat (#2) to chair back (#1). Secure by using bolts (#C) with washers (#D,E).

Secure corner holes of the seat (#2) to chair back (#1) by using bolts (#A) with washers (#D,E).

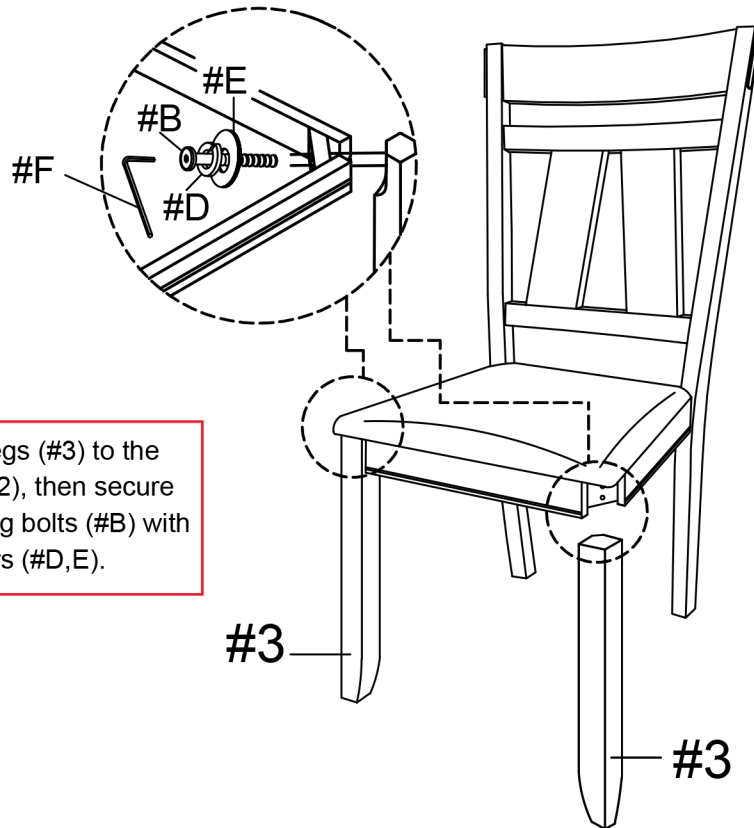
