Care Instructions

Congratulations on your purchase of this fire pit. This product is made of durable steel with a wicker embossed fire bowl in antique bronze color, a black painted iron fire screen, decorative copper color rails and 4 elegant legs.

The black paint on the fire screen will break down over time, as the fire pit is burned. We recommend the use of a high heat black spray paint to help inhibit the process.

You don't need to season your fire pit before burning. You may burn wood, synthetic logs or charcoal in your firepit. Pinon wood is ideal because if emits a pleasing aroma that also repels insects. We recommend a mixture of pinon chunks with other woods to achieve a pleasant burning experience.

Some woods tend to crackle and spark more than others. Wind can also blow burning embers around the firepit. In order to safeguard against blowing sparks/embers, make sure you have the screen securely in place while using your firepit.

ASSEMBLY STEPS:

STEP 1:


Insert Screen Handle (A) into hole at top of Mesh Screen (B) and tighten with 1 piece M6 Nut (AA) on underside of screen.

Attach Supporter (E) to the Fire Bowl (C) with 4 pieces M6 Nuts (AA) and 4 pieces M6*12 Bolts (BB).

Attach Leg (F) to the Fire Bowl (C) with 8 pieces M6*12 Bolts (BB). DO NOT TIGHTEN BOLTS FULLY.

Insert the Décor Ring (D) into the opening at top of the Leg (F), and align the hole in the Décor Ring with the hole in Leg. Insert M6*40 Bolt (CC) through both holes and loosely tighten. Repeat with the remaining 3 pieces of the Décor Ring and Leg. Tighten all bolts once you have assembled all 4 pieces.

Tighten all hardware. Place assembled Mesh Screen on assembled

This is an outdoor patio firepit and should be placed in a safe, uncovered location away From combustible materials on all sides of the product.



- 2. Always keep children and pets away from the firepit. Keep all combustible items such as outdoor furniture, clothing, plants, and other items at least 24" away from the firepit.
- 3. Do not touch the surface of the firepit while in use or until completely cooled. If you must touch the firepit, use the poker provided and/or wear protective gloves. Failure to follow this instruction will result in physical injury.
- 4. This firepit is intended for outdoor use only. Do not use the firepit indoors in an enclosed area such as a tent, gazebo, patio or porch. Proper ventilation is required to prevent carbon monoxide poisoning which
- 5. Do not use this firepit on wooden decks or other combustible surfaces. Make sure the firepit is located on a hard, level, non-combustible surface.
- 6. This firepit is intended to burn wood logs only. Do not overload the firebowl with wood. Do not burn coal, leaves or any other combustible materials in the firepit.
- 7. Never leave a burning firepit unattended. Extinguish the fire completely before leaving unattended. It is also recommended that you keep a fire extinguisher handy while the firepit is in use.
- 8. When the firepit is in use, the handle on the mesh screen can reach extreme temperature that will cause injury to an unprotected hand. Please use the poker provided and/or an appropriate heat resistant glove or pad when handling. Use this product with caution and NEVER touch a hot firepit with bare hands.
- 9. Do NOT use this firepit as a cooking appliance. It is not designed to be used for grilling food. 10. To avoid surface metal corrosion or damage, do not use water to extinguish the fire. Allow logs to
- completely burn out and then cover with sand to extinguish the fire. To extend the life of the firenit, handle the surfaces once completely cooled with a soft cloth instead of bare hands.

Please use caution and common sense when burning in your firepit. Failure to adhere to the safety guidelines could result in fire damage to your deck, home or yard. Failure to exercise caution could also cause bodily injury or even death-so please be careful!

Fire screen-spark arrester dome MUST be in place at ALL times during use

CAUTION: It is not recommended to use this fire pit (fire place) on a wooden or other combustible surface or any surface that is not entirely resistant to high heat. However, if you intend to use this item on a wooden deck other combustible surface or any surface that is not entirely resistant to high heat, you must use a non-flammable and heat resistant material such as concrete pavers, brick or stone between the fire pit (fire place) and the surface.

Lighting & Operation

*BEFORE you ignite your first fire-

- *Place wood(no more than 3 large log pieces at a time), or firelog(no more than 1 at a time) in the center of the fire bowl allowing for air flow between pieces and firepit walls.
- *Use matches butane lighters or electric starters. Do NOT use gasoline, kerosene, starter fluids or other flammable liquids that might cause a flash, high heat ignition fire.
- *Check and remove ash build up in the fire bowl regularly.
