10 top wood brackets
1 star hub
10 washers
5 bolts
Wood screws
Allen wrench
Lug Wrench
15 U stakes
5 anchor feet
2 storage straps
1 platform
1 solar panel with 5 light strands
16 carabiners
21 straps

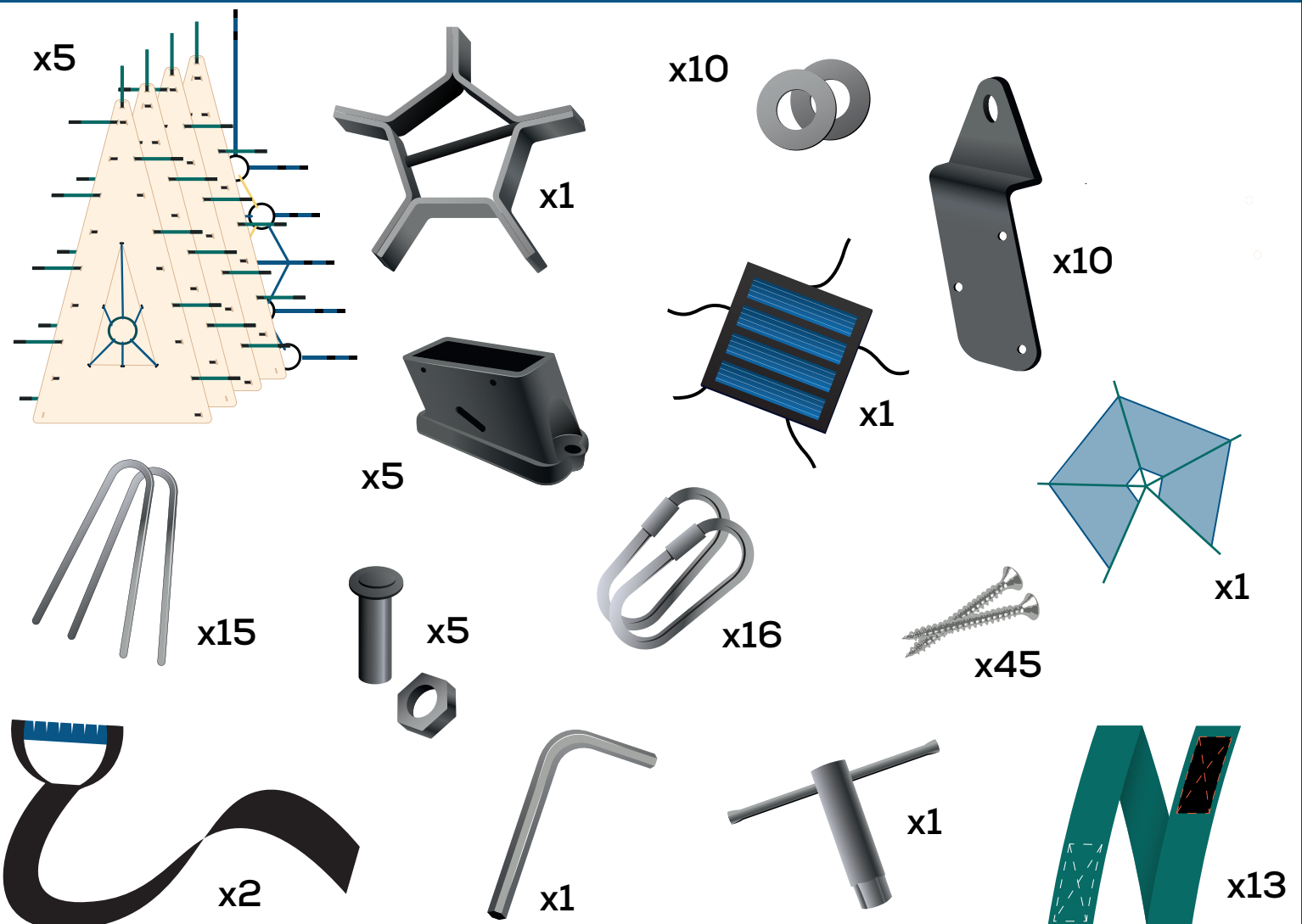

WARNING! CONSTRUCTION GRADE MATERIAL MUST BE USED. Bijou is designed for strength and must use pressure treated wood for outdoor use.



General Guidelines

- Adult Assembly only.
- Please read the following instruction carefully and use the product accordingly.
- Please keep this manual and hand it over when you transfer the product.

Notes

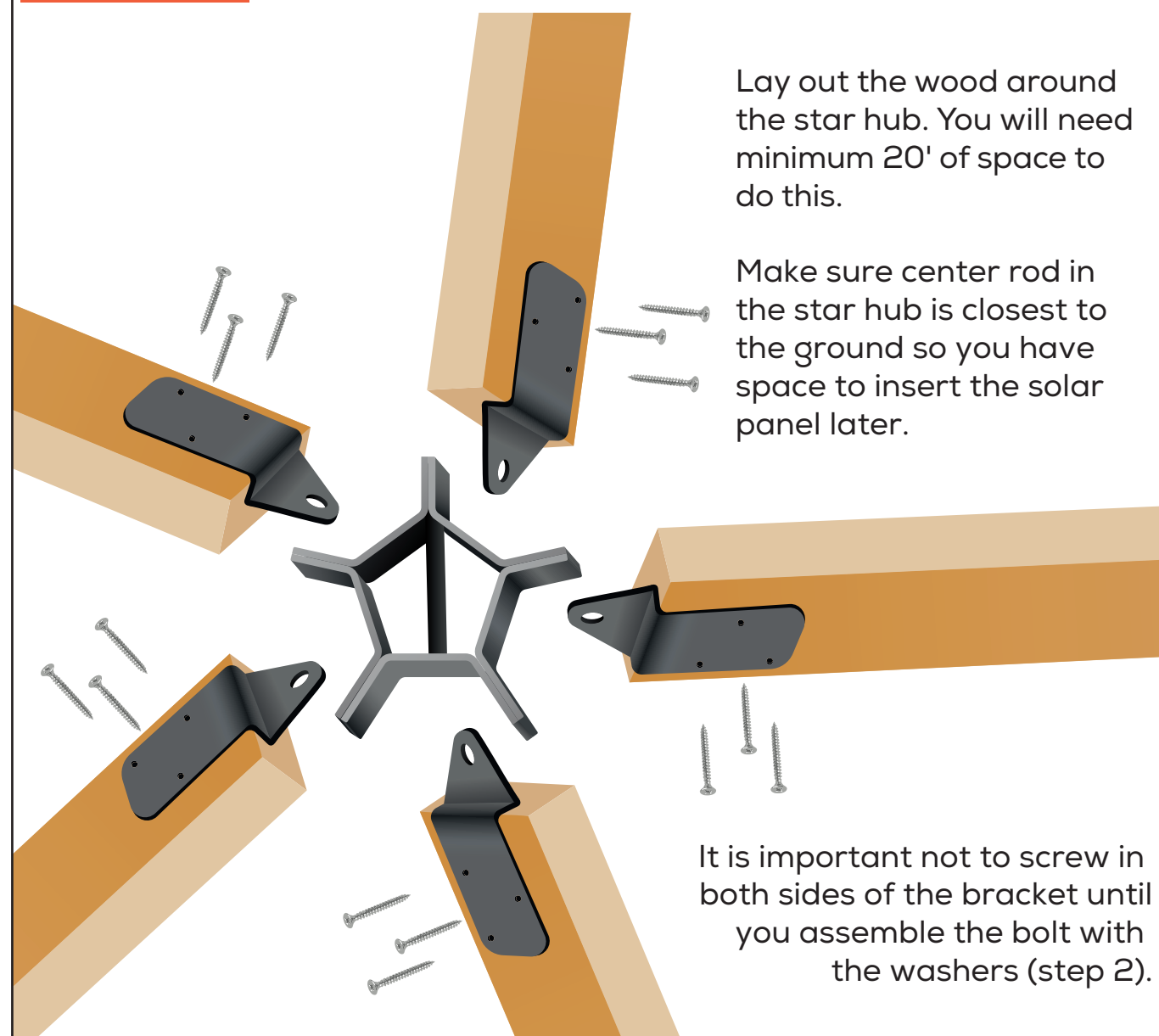
- It is recommended that two persons assemble the product. Please strictly adhere to the assembly steps.
- It is best to assemble the bracket system to the wood on a flat surface.
- Failure to properly assemble top brackets to star hub could result in structural failure.

Follow these instructions to create a safe place to Bijou

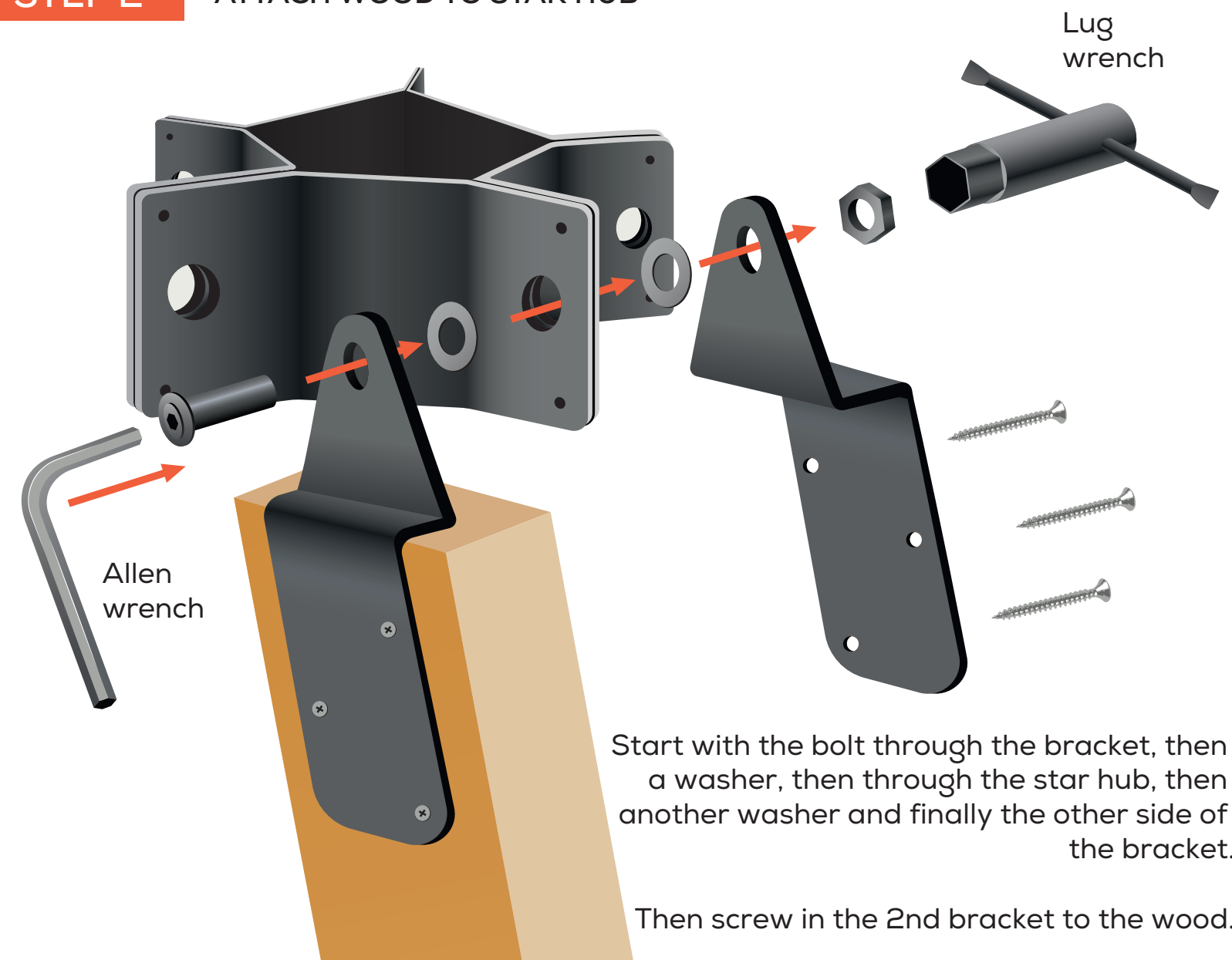
- To prevent injury, do not allow children to use the equipment until properly installed by an adult.
- Never sit on top of Bijou. This is a serious hazard that could result in serious injury.
- Place the equipment on level ground, not less than 6 ft (1.8 m) from any structure or obstruction such as a fence, garage, house, overhanging branches, laundry lines, or electrical wires.
- Do not install home playground equipment over concrete, asphalt, packed earth, grass, carpet, or any other hard surface.
- Use included ground stakes to prevent tipping, overturning, or lifting of the support members during anticipated use.
- Place metal U ground stakes, below the level of the playing surface to prevent tripping or injury resulting from a fall.
- Bijou should not be used in a manner other than intended.
- Please wear appropriate footwear and avoid clothing that could get caught.
- Please do not attach items to Bijou, such as, but not limited to, jump ropes, clothesline, pet leashes, cables and chain as they may cause a strangulation hazard. Be Safe!

Product is intended for use for children ages 3 - 103
Maximum combined weight limit 250lbs (113kg)

STEP 1 CONNECT BRACKETS TO WOOD- Screw 1 side into the 2x4



STEP 2 ATTACH WOOD TO STAR HUB

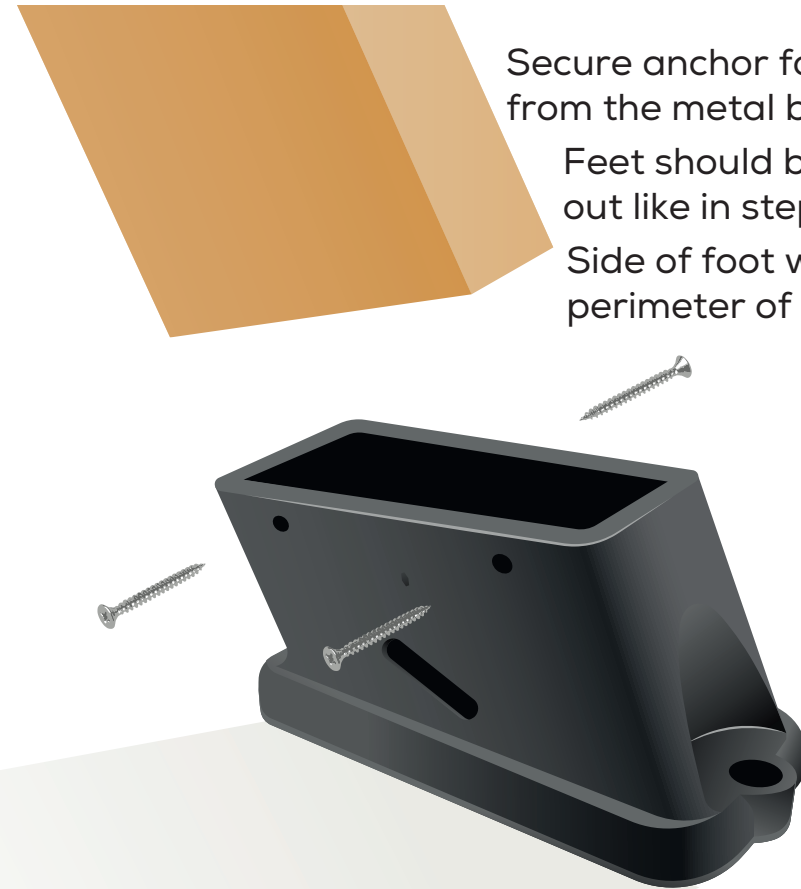


STEP 3 ATTACH ANCHOR FEET

Secure anchor foot on the other end of the wood from the metal brackets.

Feet should be put on when the wood is spread out like in step 1.

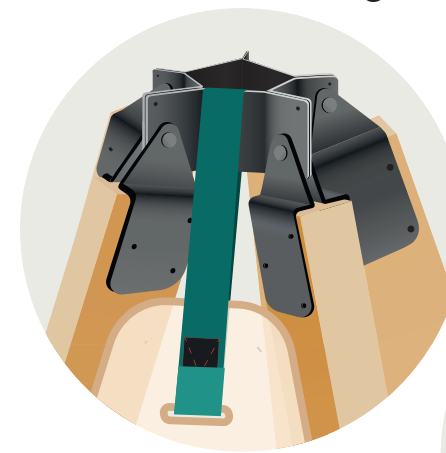
Side of foot with indent should face the outside perimeter of the final assembled Bijou.



STEP 4 ATTACH PANELS TO THE STAR HUB

Before you raise Bijou, attach the TOP straps to the star hub and the FIRST straps down to the wood.

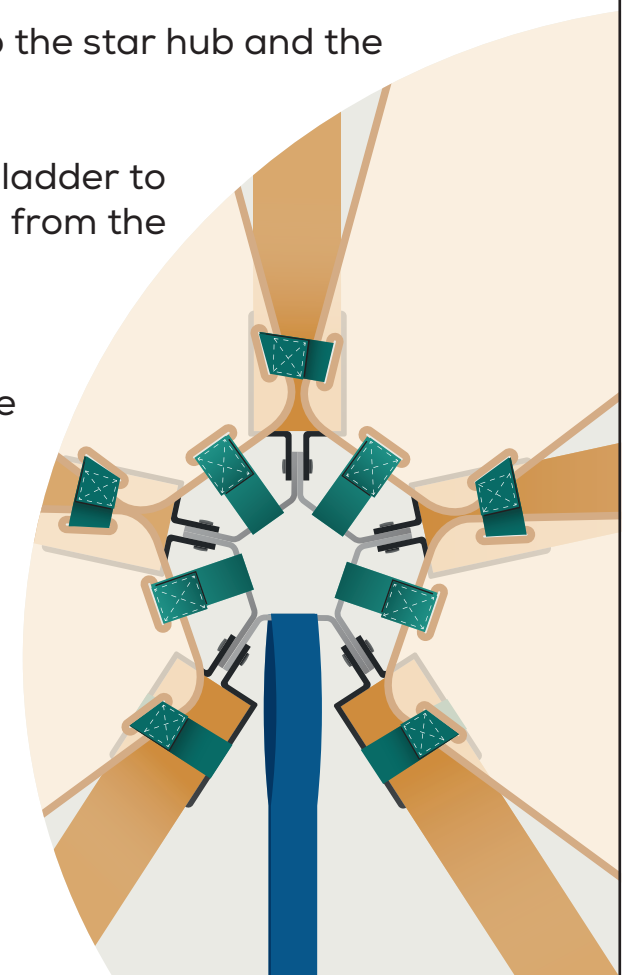
Once Bijou is raised (step 6), you will use a step ladder to attach all the other straps to the wood, starting from the top down, following step number 7.



Loop top strap around the star hub and secure with velcro.



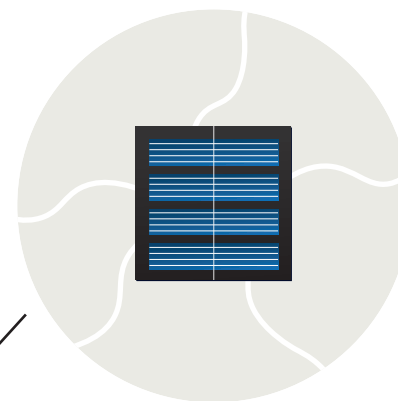
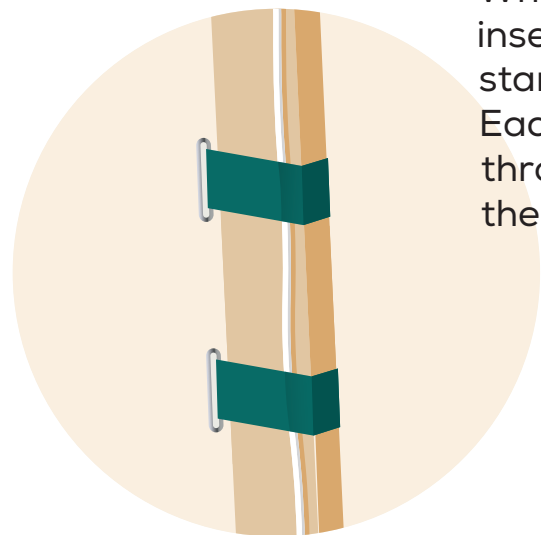
Cargo net will attach with included carabiner, to the star hub.



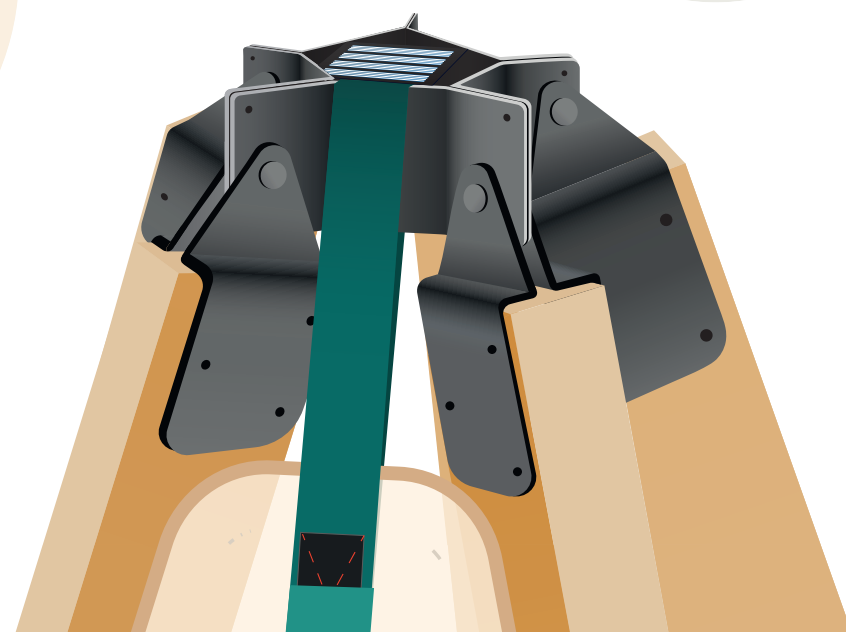
STEP 5 INSTALLING THE SOLAR PANEL

While Bijou is on the ground, insert the solar panel into the star hub.

Each light strand should feed through the star hub before the panel is inserted.



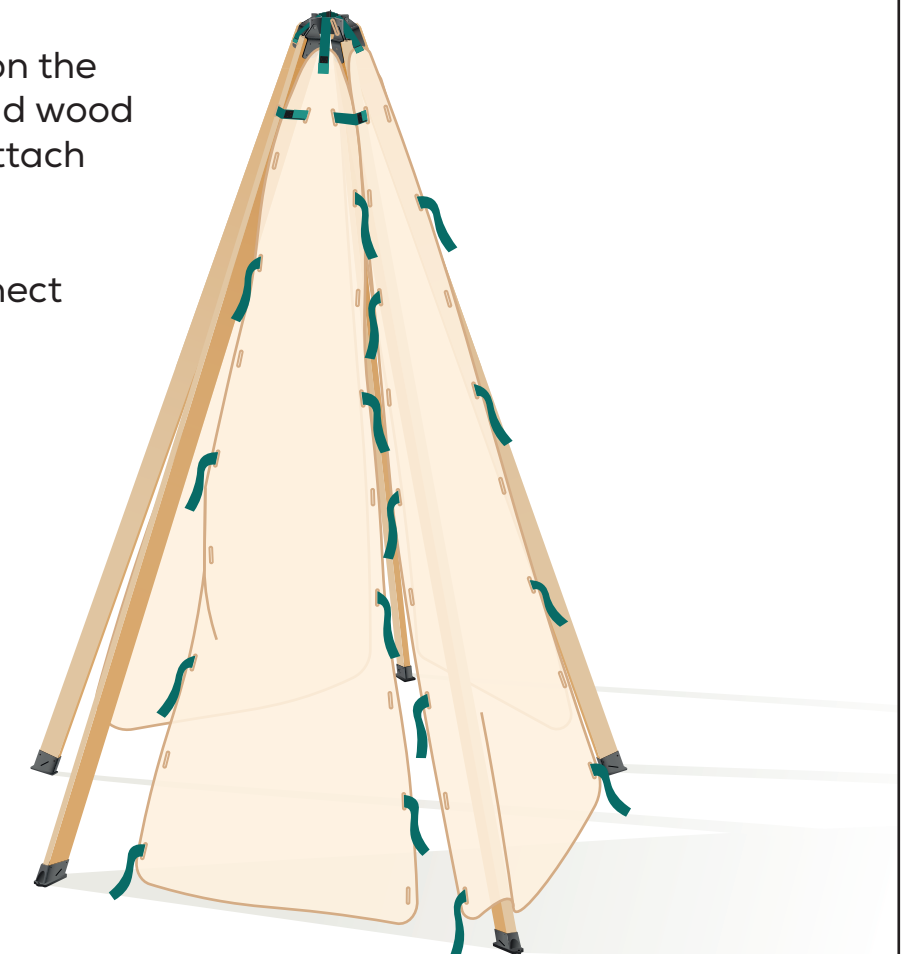
Each strand goes through the velcro straps after the panels are attached to the wood in step 6.



STEP 6 STAND UP BIJOU TO ATTACH THE REST OF THE PANELS

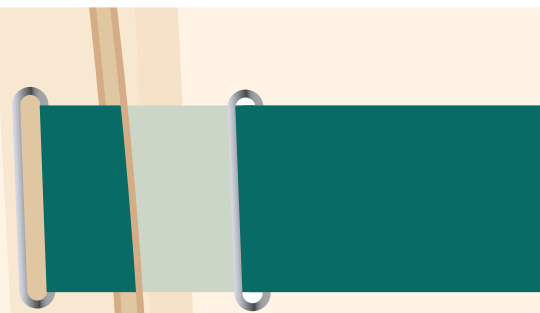
Panels/ cargo net will be loose on the frame at this point, do not extend wood too far or you wont be able to attach the panels

Work from the top down to connect the straps

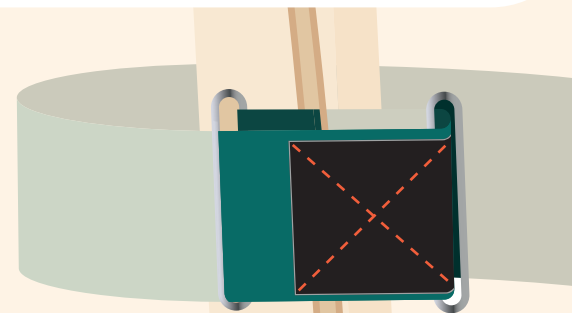

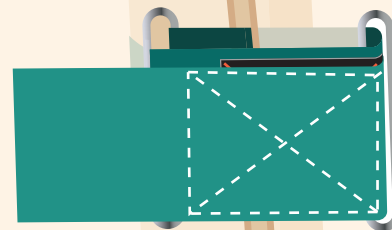

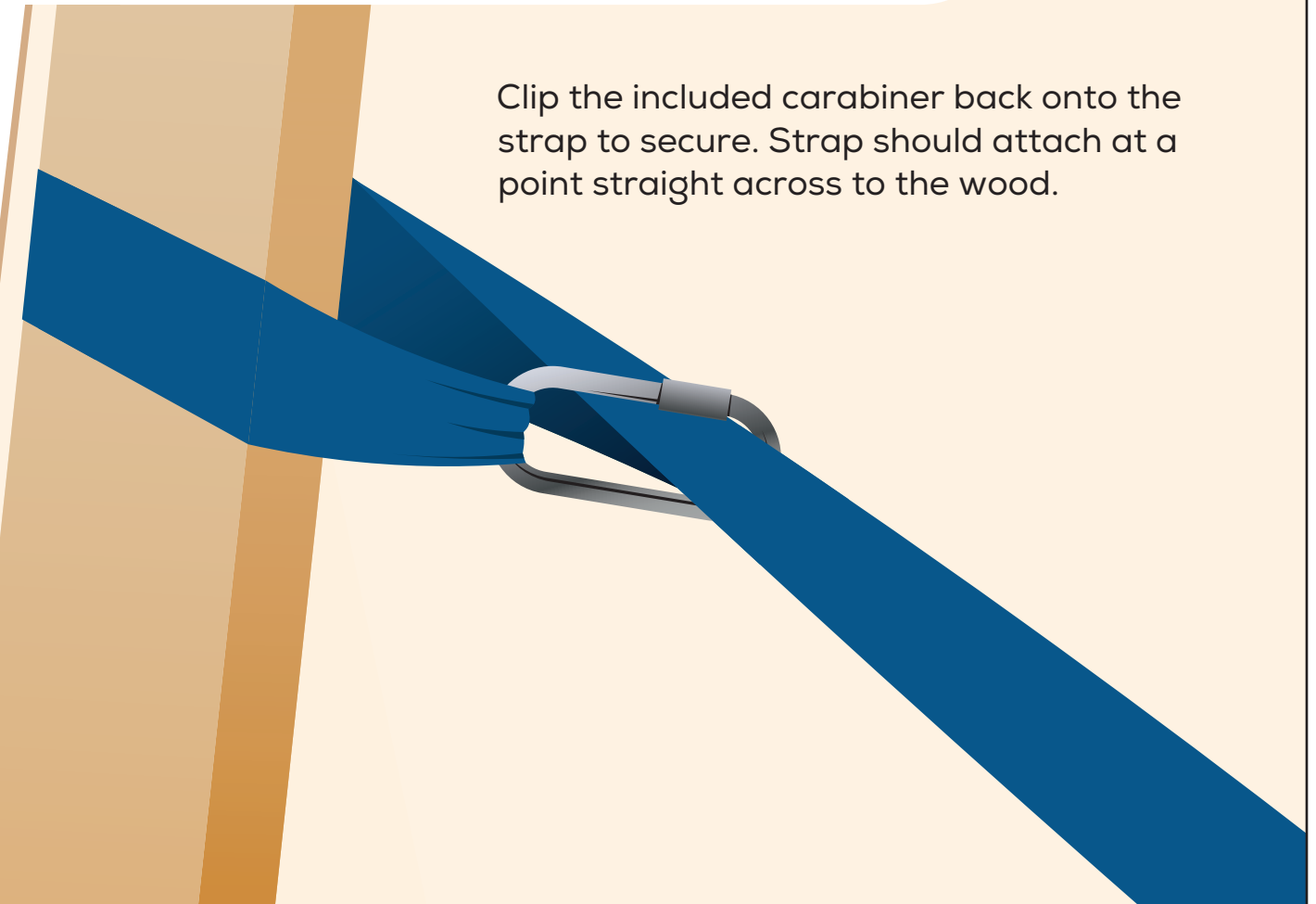

ATTACHING CARGO NET PANEL

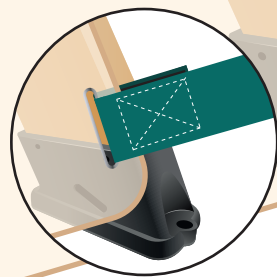
Clip the included carabiner back onto the strap to secure. Strap should attach at a point straight across to the wood.

ATTACHING FOOT STRAPS WITH 2 PANELS

Attach strap to grommet

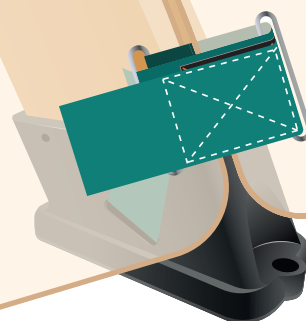
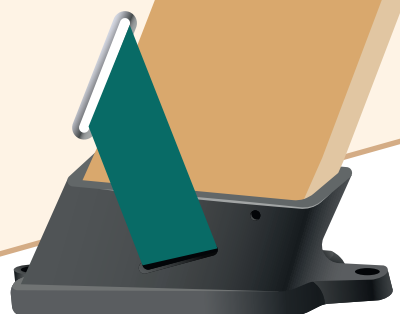

ATTACHING FOOT STRAPS WITH 1 PANEL ON CARGO NET SIDE

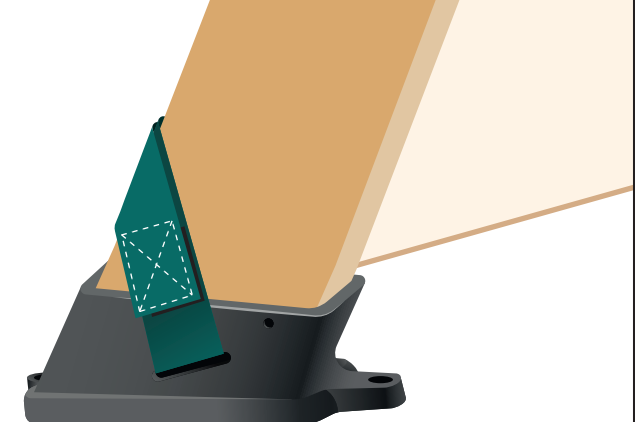
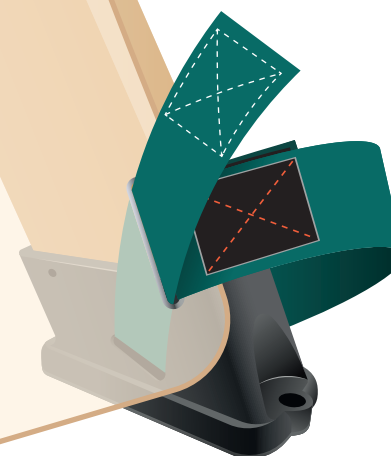

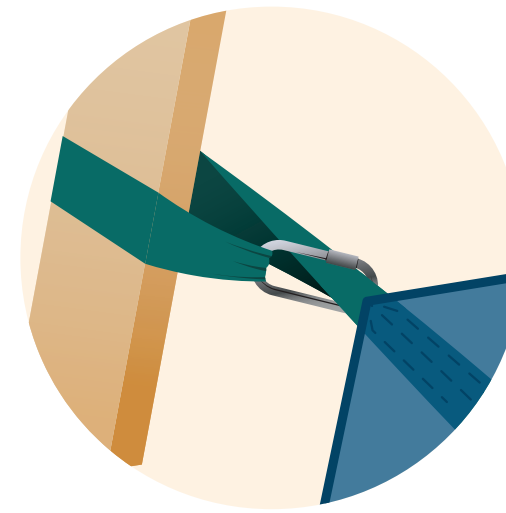
STEP 9 OPENING BIJOU

Once all panels are connected, with at least 2 adults, pull outward from the bottom of the wood until all the panels are tight.

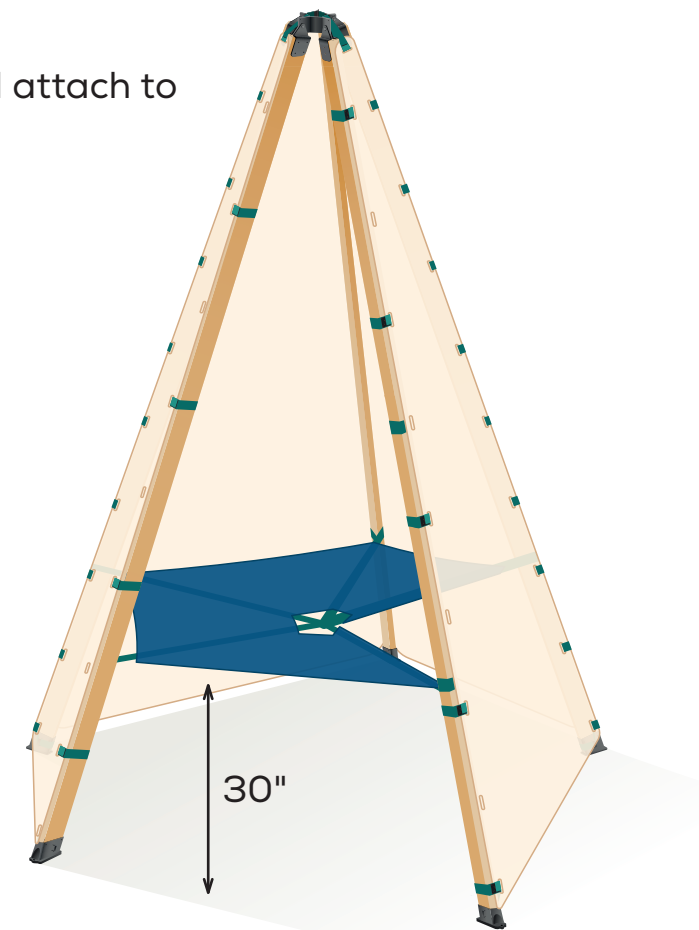


STEP 10 INSTALL PLATFORM

Simply loop the strap around the wood and attach to the strap with the included carabiners



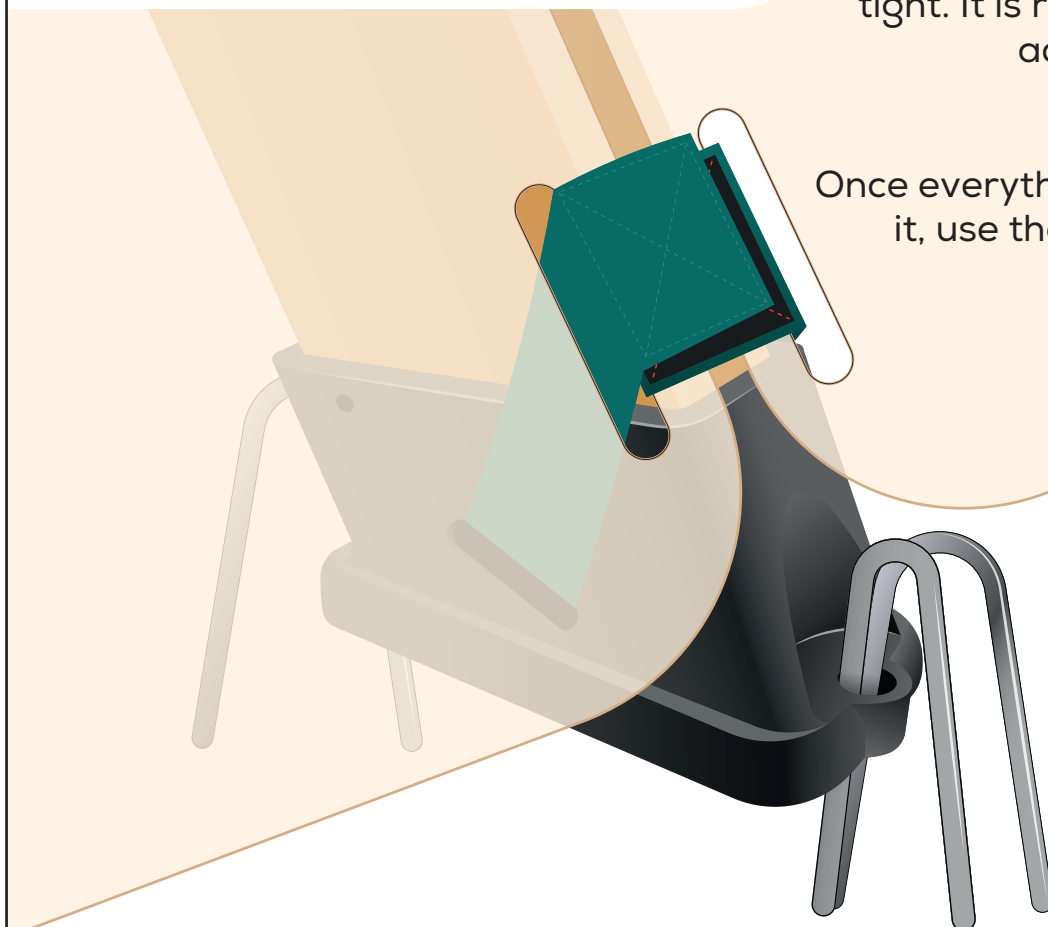
Connection around the wood should happen approximately 30" from the ground.
Sewn in straps of the platform should face the ground.



STEP 11 ANCHORING BIJOU

Pull open Bijou until each panel is tight. It is recommended to have adults spreading 2 legs simultaneously.

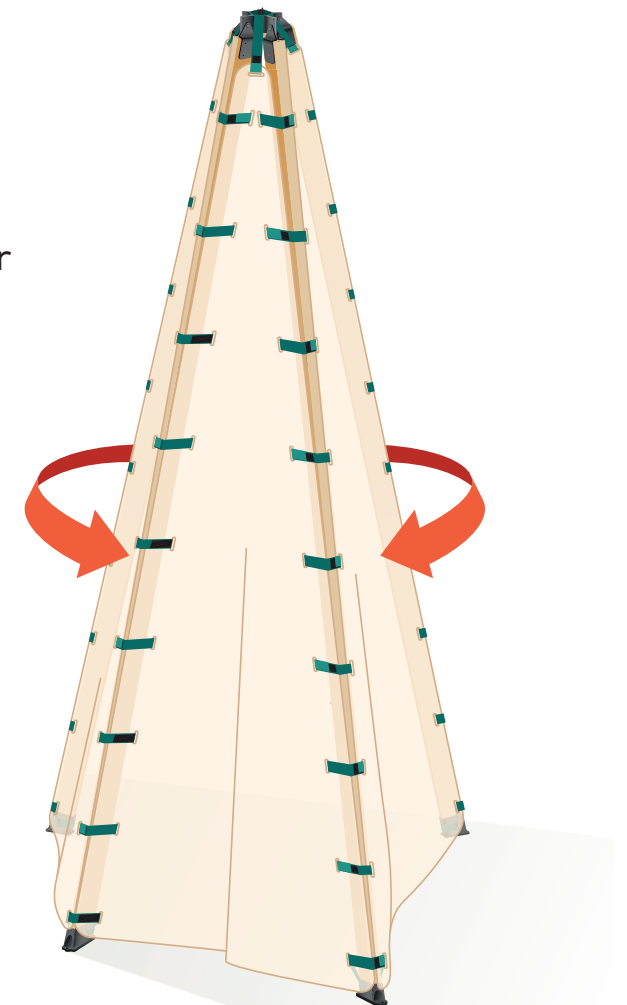
Once everything is where you want it, use the included U stakes to anchor the feet.



Use 2 anchors on the outside perimeter of the foot and 1 on the inside.

STEP 12 COLLAPSING BIJOU

When you want to store Bijou, simply remove the ground stakes and with 2 adults, walk the wood towards each other until Bijou closes.

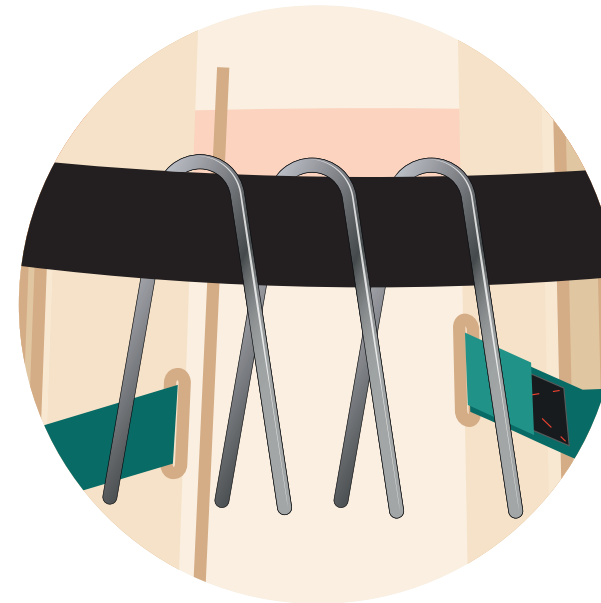
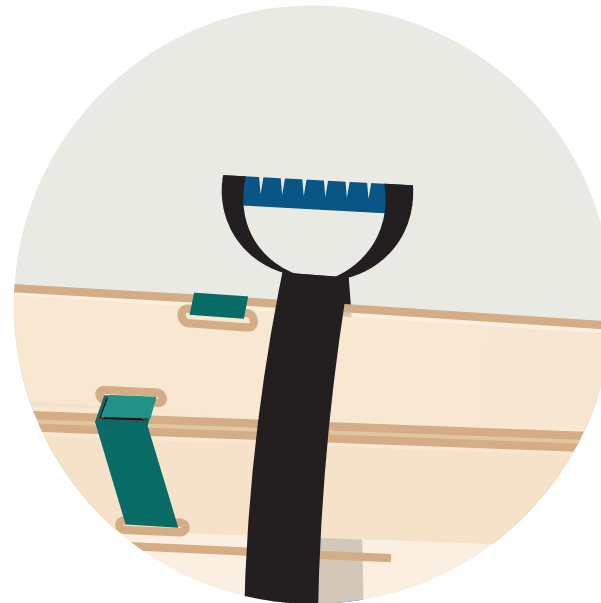


STEP 13 STORING YOUR BIJOU



Use the included straps to wrap around Bijou and secure with velcro. You can hook the U stakes around the straps for storage.

Make sure the carrying handles are on the same side so you can easily carry with 2 adults. Do not store Bijou wet or outdoors as mold may develop over time. If the panels are dirty, simply wash with soap and water and a scrub brush.



WARNING! ⚠ DOMESTIC OUTDOOR USE ONLY

Bijou is designed to be used in a domestic/ residential setting. It is not intended for commercial use. Bijou MUST be staked into the ground for stability so it is for outdoor use only. Ground stakes must be used

WARNING! ⚠ FALL HAZARD

Never climb above 8ft/ 2.4m from the ground. Falls can result in injury or death

WARNING! ⚠ ADULT ASSEMBLY ONLY

Bijou should be assembled by adults. There are small parts and sharp screws that could pose a hazard to children. Assembly should be complete before children climb or use the Bijou

WARNING! ⚠ CONSTRUCTION GRADE MATERIAL USED

Bijou is designed to be assembled with pressure treated 2x4s from your local hardware store. This means some of the wood may be rough and splinters are possible. If there are any particularly rough spots, it is recommended to sand to smooth.

WARNING! ⚠ FOR AGES 3-103

UP TO 250lbs/ 113kgs

Maintenance

At the beginning of each play season:

- Tighten all hardware.
- Lubricate all metallic moving parts with WD-40 as needed.
- Check all protective coverings on bolts, pipes, edges, and corners. Replace if they are loose, cracked, or missing.
- Check all moving parts including swing seats, ropes, cables, and chains for wear, rust, or other deterioration. Replace as needed.
- Check metal parts for rust. If found, sand and repaint using a nonlead-based paint meeting the requirements of 16 CFR 1303.
- Check all wood members for deterioration and splinters. Sand down splinters and replace deteriorating wood members.
- Reinstall any plastic parts, such as swing seats or any other items that were removed for the cold season.
- Rake and check depth of loose fill protective surfacing materials to prevent compaction and to maintain appropriate depth. Replace as necessary.

Twice a month during play season:

- Tighten all hardware.
- Check all protective coverings on bolts, pipes, edges, and corners. Replace if they are loose, cracked, or missing.
- Rake and check depth of loose fill protective surfacing materials to prevent compaction and to maintain appropriate depth. Replace as necessary.
- Once a month during play season:
- Lubricate all metallic moving parts per manufacturer's instructions.
- Check all moving parts including swing seats, ropes, cables, and chains for wear, rust, or other deterioration. Replace as needed.

At the end of each play season or when the temperature drops below 32°F

- Remove plastic swing seats and other items as specified by the manufacturer and take indoors or do not use.
- Rake and check depth of loose fill protective surfacing materials to prevent compaction and to maintain appropriate depth. Replace as necessary.
- Owners shall be responsible for maintaining the legibility of the warning labels.

Disposal Instructions

- Should you need to dispose of Bijou, please disassemble and dispose of all components in such a way that no unreasonable hazards will exist at the time the playground equipment is discarded. We hope you never dispose though.
