## Formaldehyde

Crosley, like many other manufacturers use formaldehyde but our products do not contain dangerous or toxic amounts of it. There are federal agencies that monitor this very closely and have created legislations regarding this such as California Proposition 65 and California Air Resources Board (CARB), all of which our products comply with. Our units have passed all testing standards but due to the laws in place we have to include warning labels advising you the item contains chemicals. Please use products as intended, do not burn, boil, or consume the product.

### **Strong Odors**

Much like a new car, a freshly unwrapped piece of furniture often carries a distinct scent. The odor is a result of the release of organic chemicals used to create a lasting finish on your new furnishings. These chemicals are common in many household products. They are not harmful in any way and comply with all US regulations including California Proposition 65. The best solution is to let the piece of furniture air out with doors and drawers open. After 5-7 days, there should be little to no smell.
