Allium are in the same family as garlic, onions, chives and shallots. This makes gardeners wonder if they should include them in their ornamental gardening plans, as it conjures up images of supermarket produce. Because good garden designs are often made up of different shapes, Alliums rounded blooms make for high drama and interest in the garden. The Allium group gets more popular annually, from over 300 species to choose. They amaze everyone, and few plants create this kind of wow in the garden.

About This Variety: Allium Purple Sensation produces silver green, basal leaves which die by flowering time. The bloom carries numerous star-shaped, purplish pink flowers in a dense, spherical umbel. Excellent nectar source for pollinators. Plant about 9 bulbs per square feet.

*Growing Instructions:* As Alliums do not like wet feet, find a sunny location where the soil drains well or try to improve the drainage. The bulbs will rot in wet areas. Aside from that, almost no maintenance is required.

Care Tip: Dig, divide, and replant bulbs after a few years of decreasing flower production.

*Exposure:* Full sun to partial shade *Height:* Grows 22-32" tall *Spacing:* Plant 6-8" apart, 4-6" deep *USDA Zones:* Hardy in USDA zones 2-10
