





- Assemble your unit on a carpeted floor or on the empty carton to avoid scratching your unit or the floor.
- ◆ Turn eight CAM SCREWS (1) into the TOP (A).












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
◆ Push eight HIDDEN CAMS (2) into the ENDS (C and D) and the UPRIGHTS (E and F).




- ◆ Push the WOOD DOWELS (3) into the exact hole shown in the UPRIGHTS (E and F).
- ◆ Fasten the LEFT MOLDING (K) to the LEFT UPRIGHT (E).
- ◆ Fasten the RIGHT MOLDING (L) to the RIGHT UPRIGHT (F).
- ◆ Use four 1-3/8"mm Pan Head Screws.
- ◆ NOTE: You should align each SCREW to the holes before completely tightening any of them.












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◆ Fasten sixteen GLASS CLIPS (5) to the ENDS (C and D) and UPRIGHTS (E and F). Use sixteen 1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS




- Fasten the TOP MOLDING (J) to the TOP (A). Use three 1-3/8"mm Pan Head Screws.
- NOTE: You should align each SCREW to the holes before completely tightening any of them.








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- Push the WOOD DOWELS (3) into the exact hole shown in the TOP (A).
- Fasten the UPRIGHTS (E and F) and the ENDS (C and D) to the TOP (A). Tighten eight HIDDEN CAMS.











- Slide the BACK (G) into the grooves of theLEFT UPRIGHT (E) and LEFT END (C).
- ♦ Slide the BACK (G) into the grooves of theRIGHT UPRIGHT (F) and the RIGHT END (D).




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- Push the WOOD DOWELS (3) into the exact hole shown in the UPRIGHTS (E and F) and the ENDS (C and D). Fasten (B) to the ENDS (C and D), UPRIGHTS (E and F).
- ◆ Use eight 1-3/8 " PAN HEAD SCREWS (9).
- NOTE: You should align each SCREW to the holes before completely tightening any of them.




Fasten the END LEGS (O) to the BOTTOM MOLDINGS (P). Use four 1-5/8" HEX HEAD SCREWS (8) with the L-WRENCH.




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Fasten the LEGS to the BOTTOM (B). Use ten HEX HEAD SCREWS (10) with the L-WRENCH.




♦ Fasten the SHORT LEGS (Q) to the BOTTOM (B). Use eight 1/2" PAN HEAD SCREWS.




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- Push eight CLIPS (6) between the BACKS (G) and connecting BOTTOM(B), ENDS (C and D), UPRIGHTS (E and F)and TOP(A).
- ♦ Then, fasten the CLIPS (10) with eight 5/8" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (13).



- ◆ Set the SHELVES (H) onto the GLASS CLIP (5).
- Fasten the screw of Glass CLIP to fixed the SHELVES (H) in position.






- Insert the METAL PINS (14) into the hole locations of your choice in the UPRIGHTS (E and F).
- ◆ Set the ADJUSTABLE SHELF (R) onto the METAL PINS.



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- Peel APPLIQUES from the APPLIQUE CARDS (4) and stick them onto each visible HIDDEN CAM. This completes assembly. Clean with a damp cloth. Wipe dry.
- Apply the WARNING LABEL (15) to the TOP (A). You should be able to read the label when the TV is removed from the unit. When the TV is in place, it should hide the label. Peel off the backing and apply the label as shown in the diagram.
- ♦ NOTE: This is a permanent label intended to last for the life of the product. Once applied, do not try to remove it.
- ◆ This completes assembly. Clean with a damp cloth. Wipe dry.






