



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR ROLLER SHADES



Parts List

Quantity

Shade	1
Slat for Hem Pocket	1
Brackets	2
Mounting Screws	4
Plastic Anchors	4 (For Drywall or Plaster Mounting)



Tools Required

Screwdriver, Tape measure, Step stool or Ladder, Pencil, Drill*

* Use 3/32" drill bit to predrill screw holes.

Use 1/4" drill bit for wall anchors.

1. Bracket Location & Installation

Your window shade can be installed either inside the window frame or outside the window frame or on the ceiling. When measuring and installing shades, make sure there is a "play" between the roller and the brackets. Shades mounted too tight in the brackets will not function properly. Attach brackets to inside or outside of casing or to the ceiling.

2. Mounting the Shade

For Inside Mounting: Allow 1/4" clearance between top of frame and fully rolled-up shade. This will provide enough clearance to lift shade into slotted bracket. Spring loaded tip provides up to 3/8" extra width if needed. Always insert the pin end into the right side bracket first. If the brackets are installed as illustrated (facing out), place the pin into the inner hole of the right bracket. If the brackets are installed facing down (like Ceiling Mount), place the pin into the outer hole of the right bracket. Push into bracket to compress the spring, then place the metal tab on the left side of the shade into the slot of the left bracket.

For Outside Mounting / Ceiling Mount: Hold shade to desired position, making sure it is level, and place pencil marks at each end of the roller. Secure brackets. Insert the round pin end into the inner hole of the right bracket. For ceiling mount, insert the pin into the outer hole. Then insert the other end of the shade into the slot of the left bracket.

For reverse-roll shades (inside mount only!), the slotted bracket goes on the right, and the open part of the bracket must face the window – the bracket should be mounted to the top of the window frame [see illustration].

3. Adjusting for Roller Tension


To tighten, lower the shade about 18 inches from the top, remove from window brackets. Roll up shade all the way to the top by hand, then replace in brackets.

To loosen, raise the shade to the top and remove from brackets. Unroll about 18 inches and replace in brackets. Repeat until there is a proper tension. Roller should not be too tight. Remember, when a window shade refuses to roll up, the spring is too loose. When it won't stay down, the roller spring is too tight.

Caution: Overwinding may result in permanent damage.

4. How to Operate

If this shade does not roll straight, correct as follows:



Make sure brackets are mounted level, or the shade will not roll straight. If shade veers toward the right, correct by lowering shade completely and placing a piece of tape (multiple pieces may be necessary) as close to the left edge of the roller as possible. It will act as a shim.

If shade veers toward the left, correct by lowering shade completely and placing a piece of tape (multiple pieces may be necessary) as close to the right edge of the roller as possible. It will act as a shim.

5. Care

Cleans easily with a damp sponge or soft cloth. Allow the shade to hang it's full length for a minimum of 72 hours to minimize wrinkles and creases.

4. Como Operar

Si la persiana no enrolls uniformemente, arréglela de la siguiente manera: Asegúrese que los soportes estén nivelados, de lo contrario, la persiana no subirá derecho. Si la persiana vira hacia la derecha, bájela completamente y ponga un pedazo de cinta tan cerca al extremo izquierdo como sea posible (tantas como necesite), esto actuará como cuña. Si la persiana vira hacia la izquierda, repita el proceso pero esta vez coloque cintas tan cerca al extremo derecho como sea posible (cuantas sean necesarias). Esto hará los mismo, actuará como cuña.

5. Cuidado

Limpie con esponja o paño suave. Déjela suelta al menos 72 horas para minimizar arrugas y pliegues.

1. Ubicación e Instalación de Soportes

Su persiana puede instalarse ya sea dentro del marco de la ventana, por fuera de este en el techo. Cuando mida e instale persianas, asegúrese que hay “juego” entre el rodillo y los soportes. Las persianas que se instalan demasiado apretadas no funcionarán apropiadamente. Asegure los soportes dentro o fuera de la ventana o en el techo. El soporte con ranura va al lado izquierdo y el de hoyos va al lado derecho.

2. Montaje de la Persiana

Para Montaje Interior: Deje 1/4" entre la parte superior del marco y la persiana totalmente enrollada. Esto permitirá tener espacio suficiente para levantar y colocar la persiana en el soporte con ranura. La punta con resorte provee hasta 3/8" extra de ancho. Siempre inserte el extremo al soporte del lado derecho primero. Si los soportes se instalan como se ilustra (mirando hacia afuera), introduzca el perno en el orificio interior del soporte derecho. Si los soportes se instalan mirando hacia abajo (como sería en el montaje al techo), introduzca el perno en el orificio exterior del soporte derecho. Presiónelo al soporte para comprimir el resorte y luego introduzca la lengüeta del otro extremo en la ranura del soporte del lado izquierdo.

Para Montaje Exterior o al Techo: Mantenga la persiana en la posición deseada desenrollela que está nivelada, marque con un lápiz a cada extremo del rodillo. Asegure los soportes. Inserte la punta redonda del perno en el orificio interno del soporte derecho.

Para montaje al techo, inserte el perno en el orificio externo. Luego inserte el otro extremo de la persiana en el orificio del soporte de la izquierda.

Para persiana de enrollado marcha-atrás (montaje interior únicamente!) El soporte con ranura va a la derecha, y la parte abierta del soporte debe estar dirigido a la ventana – el soporte debe ubicarse al tope o al lado del marco de la ventana. [mire la ilustración].

3. Ajuste y Tensión del Rodillo

Para apretar, baje la persiana a aproximadamente 18 pulgadas del tope, remueva de los soportes. Desenrollela nuevamente a mano y colóquela en los soportes nuevamente. Para aflojar, suba la persiana hasta el tope, remuévala de los soportes, desenrollela a mano a aproximadamente 18 pulgadas y vuelva a ponerla en los soportes. Repita hasta que consiga una tensión adecuada. El Rodillo no deberá estar muy apretado. Recuerde, cuando la persiana se rehusa a subir es porque el resorte está muy flojo, cuando no se queda abajo es porque el resorte está muy apretado.

Precaución: Exceso de enrollado podría resultar en daño permanente.




Step 1. Mount the Brackets

The brackets can be face mounted, top mounted or side mounted – attach the brackets to the window frame, molding or ceiling as illustrated. The brackets are “universal” – there are no “right” and “left” brackets.



Step 2. Install the Shade


Put the spring loaded pin into the round hole of the bracket, push the spring loaded tip into the bracket, and then insert the hook arms on the opposite side of the shade into the two hook arm receiver holes of the bracket. Once the two hook arms are through the holes, gently pull down until the two hook arms have locked securely to the bracket.



Step 2A. Cassette Installation (for shades with optional Cassette Valance)


The shade is pre-mounted in the cassette. It can be removed to adjust tension, if necessary.

To attach the cassette outside the window frame, use the rear bracket holes as illustrated.





To attach the Cassette inside the window frame (or to the ceiling), use the top bracket holes as illustrated.

Attach the Cassette by placing the back-bottom of the head rail into the bottom of each mounting bracket. Push forward and up, snapping the rail into the top of the mounting bracket.

**Step 3. Install the Bracket Covers****– For Outside Mount Shades Only!**

Bracket covers slide onto the brackets as shown until they snap into position.

**Step 4. Operating the Shade**

Raise the Shade: Grip the center of the bottom hem (do not release your grip until you have set the shade at the desired height) – pull the shade away from the window sill, if necessary – pull straight down to release the spring motor that controls the movement of the shade – allow it to rise to any desired point, then pull downward gently to stop/set the shade.

Lower the Shade: Pull straight down and stop/set the shade as described above.

Step 5. Adjust Spring Tension

This shade has a reliable long-lasting

Spring Motor. The Spring Motor must have proper tension in order to function as intended. Handling in transit can affect spring tension. Therefore, please give special attention to the instructions below to optimize the performance of your shade.

Spring Tension should be adjusted to assure best performance and to suit personal preference. The tension on the spring should be neither too loose nor too tight. When a window shade refuses to roll up, the spring is too loose. When it won't stay down the roller spring is too tight.

To Increase Tension: lower the shade about 18 inches from the top, and then remove it from the brackets. Roll-Up the shade all the way to the top by hand, and then place the shade back into the brackets as described in Step 2. Repeat as often as necessary to achieve desired tension.

Caution: over-winding may result in permanent damage to the spring motor.

To Decrease Tension: remove the shade from the brackets, and then unroll about 18 inches of shade material, and then place the shade back into the brackets as described in Step 2. Repeat as often as necessary to achieve desired tension.

Cleaning the Shades

Dusting: Vacuum using the soft brush attachment. Washing: Use a cloth, sponge or soft brush and a mild detergent. Use warm or cold water, not hot water. Place toweling on the floor or window sill and wash the blind in sections.

Step 1. Mount the Brackets

Attach the brackets to the window frame, molding or ceiling. For Inside Mount, the base of each bracket must face upward (the brackets cannot be side mounted). The bracket for the cord control end of the shade has a post that fits into the end of the cord mechanism (see illustration).

The other bracket is for the pin end of the shade. This bracket has a locking gate that opens to allow the pin end of



the shade to slide into the bracket (see illustration).

Mark the screw locations with a pencil – pre-drill the screw holes using a 5/64" drill bit. If mounting to hollow drywall, use the wall anchors provided – pre-drill the holes with a 1/4" drill bit.

Step 2. Mounting the Shade

Important – do not remove the Twist-Tie from the Cord Control & Chain until the shade has been attached to the brackets.


Push the cord control mechanism onto the bracket post such that the cord hangs straight down.

Open the gate on the pin end bracket by pushing on the tab (see illustration). Slide the pin end of the shade into the bracket such that it rests in the center recess. Close the gate making sure that it snaps shut.

Step 3. Attach the Tension Device

The Tension Device must be attached per these instructions in order for your shade to function properly. Carefully unwrap the control cord/chain and tension device. Cut and remove the zip-tie.

While holding the tension device in one hand, pull the plunger away from the bead chain with the other hand. Lift the bead chain out of the bead locking groove and slide the tension device to the bottom

of the chain loop. Pull the tension device down until the bead chain is fully tensioned (plunger will be at the top) and then move the tension device up approximately 1/8". Mark the screw locations on the wall or window frame with a pencil.

Inside Mount: If mounting into wood, predrill screw holes and then install the tension device using the 1" Phillips head screws provided.

If not securing into wood, use appropriate anchors for the substrate and follow the anchor manufacturer's instructions.

Outside Mount: Align the mounting bracket screw holes with the pencil marks. If mounting into wood, predrill screw holes and then install the mounting bracket using the 1" Phillips head screws provided.

If not securing into wood, use appropriate anchors for the substrate and follow manufacturer's instructions.

Press the tension device onto the mounting bracket posts. Carefully install the 3/8" Phillips head screws provided, through the tension device into the mounting bracket using a Phillips head screwdriver.

DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN!.

Step 4. Operating the Shade

Pulling the cord smoothly and slowly in one direction raises the shade; pulling it in the other direction lowers it. On shades where the fabric rolls against the window, the front cord lifts the shade.

On shades where the fabric rolls toward the room, the rear cord lifts the shade.

Cleaning the Shades

Vacuum using the soft brush attachment.







For cord control shades, the bottom of the clutch should always point straight down.



Step 3. Install the Bracket Covers

– For Outside Mount Shades Only!

Bracket covers slide onto the brackets as shown until they snap into position.




Step 4. Cassette Installation


(for shades with optional Cassette Valance)

The shade is pre-mounted in the cassette. It can be removed to adjust tension, if necessary.


To attach the cassette outside the window frame, use the rear bracket holes as illustrated.



To attach the cassette inside the window frame (or to the ceiling), use the top bracket holes as illustrated.



Attach the cassette by placing the back-bottom of the head rail into the bottom of each mounting bracket. Push forward and up, snapping the rail into the top of the mounting bracket.

Step 5. Install the Chain Tension Device


The tension device must be installed to make sure the shade is fully operable.

Before doing anything, you must first slide the tension device to the bottom of the bead chain.

While holding the tension device in one hand, pull the plunger away from the bead chain with the other hand. Lift the bead chain out of the bead locking groove and slide the tension device to the bottom of the chain loop.

Pull the tension device down until the bead chain is fully tensioned (plunger will be at the top) and then move the tension device up approximately 1/8".

Mark the screw hole locations on the wall with a pencil.



Inside Mount: if mounting into wood, pre-drill screw holes and then install the tension device using the 1 1/4" Phillips head screws provided.

If not securing into wood, use appropriate anchors for the substrate and follow anchor manufacturer's instructions.

Outside Mount: Align the mounting bracket screw holes with the pencil marks.

If mounting into wood, pre-drill screw holes and then install the mounting bracket using the 1 1/4" Phillips head screws provided.

If not securing into wood, use appropriate anchors for the substrate and follow manufacturer's instructions.

Press the tension device onto the mounting bracket posts. Carefully attach the Tension Device to the bracket using the 3/8" Phillips head screws provided. **DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN.**

Step 6. Operating the Shade


Pulling gently on the cord in one direction raises the shade; pulling it in the other direction lowers it.

On shades where the fabric rolls against the window, the front cord lifts the shade. On shades where the fabric rolls toward the room, the rear cord lifts the shade.

Step 7. Hold Down Brackets for Outdoor Shades

The elastic straps on each side of the bottom rail loop onto the open 'C' section of the hold down brackets as illustrated.

Attach the hold down brackets to a wall, post or other solid surface. Use 1" screws (or screws and anchors) to attach the brackets. Put tension on the straps by stretching them when positioning the brackets





INSTALL THE SHADE BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO OPERATE THE MOTOR.


Tools Required:

Tape measure, pencil, drill, drill bits, screw driver, step stool or ladder.




Note: use a 5/64" drill bit to pre-drill the screw holes (for attachment to a wall stud or header board). Use Wall Anchors (not included) for hollow dry wall or plaster mounting.

Step 1. Mount the Brackets [Note: If your shade has a Cassette Valance (the shade is pre-mounted in a decorative aluminum cover) locate the special instructions for installing the Cassette] Attach the brackets to the window frame, molding or ceiling as shown.



Note that the bracket for the motor end of the shade has a tab that fits into the motor housing. The Pin-End Bracket has a slot that the pin end slides into.




Mark the screw locations with a pencil – pre-drill the screw holes using a 5/64" drill bit.

Step 2A. Cassette Installation (for shades with optional Cassette Valance)

The shade is pre-mounted in the cassette. It can be removed to adjust tension, if necessary. To attach the cassette outside the window frame, use the rear bracket holes as illustrated.

To attach the Cassette inside the window frame (or to the ceiling), use the top bracket holes as illustrated. Attach the Cassette by placing the back-bottom of the head rail into the bottom of each mounting bracket. Push forward and up, snapping the rail into the top of the mounting bracket.
