

RECOMMENDED ITEMS

- Soft rag, duster or vacuum with soft nozzle
- Clean, soft cloth for washing
- Mild detergent or dish soap
- Bucket or spray bottle for cleaning mixture
- Clean water
- Distilled white vinegar
- Clean, soft cloth for drying

INSTRUCTIONS

Gently dust the door with either a soft rag, duster or vacuum that has a soft nozzle attachment. A quick weekly dusting helps your doors maintain their fresh, like-new finish.

For basic cleaning, mix a few drops of mild dish soap with warm water and wipe with a clean, soft cloth from top to bottom. Do not use strong cleaning solutions or abrasive cleaners.

For hard to clean areas or areas with mold, mix equal parts vinegar and water and use a soft, clean cloth, still working from the top down. Be sure to test on an inconspicuous part of the door first.

A clean water rinse should follow immediately, being sure to get rid of any soapy residue.

Dry the door with a clean, soft cloth to prevent water spots or streaks. Do not use blown air as it may cause spotting.
