CHOOSE THE RIGHT SIZE RUG FOR YOUR ROOM AND FURNITURE



LIVING ROOM

The recommended rug size for a room depends on the room's dimensions and layout, and the furniture in the space. The right size rug can create a sense of balance and warmth, while the wrong size can make a room feel disjointed or cramped. Here are some tips for choosing the right rug size for different rooms:

Living room

The rug should be longer than the sofa and extend under at least a third of it. A rug that's too small can make a large space feel cramped, while a larger rug can make a small space feel more spacious. You can leave 18–24 inches of exposed floor around the perimeter of the rug.

Furniture size

DINING ROOM

Dining room

The rug should be large enough to accommodate the table and chairs, with at least 36 inches of rug extending past the table's edges.

Table size

up to 24" round/square
up to 36" round/square
up to 48" round/square
up to 60" round/square
up to 72" round/square
up to 36" x 60" rectangle/oval
up to 48" x 72" rectangle/oval
up to 48" x 96" rectangle/oval
up to 72" x 120" rectangle/oval

Recommended rug size

6' round or square
7' round or square
8' round or square
9' round or square
10' round or square
7' x 10'
8' x 10'
9' x 12'
10' x 14'

BEDROOM

Bedroom

The rug should extend 24 inches past all sides of the bed, and underneath nightstands. If the room has seating, the rug should cover that area as well.

Bed size

Twin (39" x 75")

Full (54" x 75")

Queen (60" x 80")

King (76" x 80")

Any size

Recommended rug size

6' x 9' to 7' x 10'

7' x 10' to 8' x 10'

7' x 10' to 8' x 10'

8' x 10' to 9' x 12'

3' x 5' or 4' x 6' on each side



STYLE SIZING GUIDE

OUTDOORS

The recommended rug size for outdoor use is typically larger than for indoor rugs because it should be big enough to comfortably accommodate the majority of your outdoor furniture, meaning the front legs of chairs and tables should ideally rest on the rug, providing a grounded look and preventing tripping hazards when moving furniture around; when in doubt, opting for a larger rug is generally better to create a cohesive space.

Furniture size

up to 4'
up to 5'

up to 8'

Recommended rug size

5' x 7' or larger
6' x 9' or larger
7' x 10' or larger
8' x 10' or larger
9' x 12' or larger
