## HERE'S HOW TO TAKE CARE OF ME

## Fiddle Leaf Fig



### LIGHT

I grow best in a bright, sunny spot. I prefer at least six hours of indirect sun a day.



### WATER

Water me when the top couple inches into the soil are dry, I prefer above average humidity levels. Allow water to drain thoroughly; remove any excess water.



### FOOD

Feed me once or twice a year during Spring and Summer with a fertilizer formulated for houseplants.



### FEATURES

I have large, dramatic leaves that can purify the air and I am super easy to grow.

### GROWING TIPS

Not enough water: Leaves turn brown around the edges. Too much water: Leaves turn brown in the middle and at the edges and drop off from the bottom of the plant.
