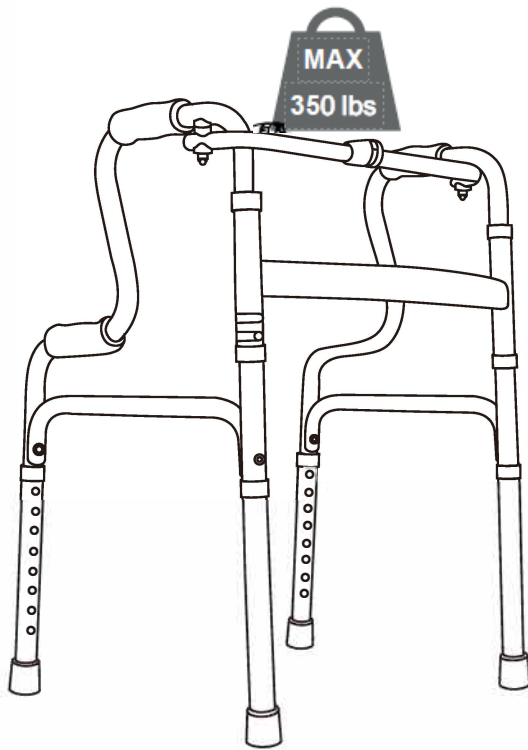

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Before You Begin:

Please identify all component parts and hardware pieces required before you begin. Carefully remove all of the components from the packaging and set aside for assembly. Assemble on a soft surface to prevent scratching during assembly.

Caution:

Tighten all components securely before use. Failure to do so may result in personal injury.

DO NOT use any sharp objects to open plastic wrapped components as damage to product or components may result.

Please take care to operate and use the folding adjustable walker as intended. Please do not use the top or middle front bars, or the lower horizontal side braces as handholds and please ensure that all height adjustment holes on the legs are set at the same level.

Quality and Safety Guidelines

- Please read these safety instructions carefully before use and keep in a safe place for future reference.
- Consult your physician or supplier to determine the proper adjustment and use of this device.
- Regularly check all parts to ensure there is no damage to the tips, grips, or frame and that all screws are securely tightened.
- Hold firmly to the handles while using this product.
- Move forward with short steps to ensure proper balance.
- In case of falling, let the walker fall to the side to avoid contact with your body.
- Please follow the static and dynamic weight capacity limits provided on this item. If you are unsure of the weight capacities for this product, email us at customerexperience@theubiquegroup.com or call 866-552-2810.
- Before use, always ensure that the product is securely locked in the OPEN position, all attachments are locked in place, and all legs/feet are in contact with the flooring surface.
- DO NOT hang anything on the walker.
- This product is intended for adult use.
- While using this product, beware of any indentations, holes, obstacles, or other ground deformities in the path of the walker.
- This product is not intended for use as a lever or for moving furniture.
- DO NOT use on wet or icy surfaces or on stairs due to risk of injury.
- No modification may be made to this device. Use only original parts supplied by the manufacturer to replace any broken or defective parts.
- DO NOT store outdoors or in a vehicle and protect from extreme temperatures (Over 100°F or Below 32°F).

INTENDED USE:

Walking aids are used as part of a rehabilitation program when the user is recovering from an injury or surgery or as a long-term aid when the user has a permanent condition that causes difficulty with walking. This device helps maintain balance and aids in the prevention of injuries (particularly falls) allowing individuals to independently attend to their needs. Mobility aids may be used indoors or outdoors, depending on the model. Mobility aids are used to modify weight distribution so some of the weight carried through the legs while walking is transferred to the arms of the walker frame for support.

Do Not Use If You Have Any Of The Following:

Severe Cognitive Disorder
Severe Loss of Balance
Severe Motor or Perception Disorders
Weakness in the Upper Limbs
