- 1. Shut off water supply and drain lines. Clean sink surface thoroughly. Make sure mounting area is clean and dry.
- 2. Position the faucet, deck plate 16 and putty plate 20 on countertop as shown.

3. Put the washer (2) and plastic locknut (2) to tailpiece of faucet and tighten the plastic locknut by hand.

Connect to water supply lines with either:

- (A) 3/8 " O.D. Copper tubing (ball nose risers with the coupling nuts or;
- (B) 3/8 " Copper tubing (no ball) with supplied tube head interior connector or;
- (C) IPS faucet connectors (1/2 $^{\prime\prime}$)



Warning:

The supply valves and supply lines are not included.



Important:

Remove the aerator and let both hot and cold water run for one minute to clear any line trash. This will help clean any debris that might clog the system. Re-assemble aerator.

Test system for leaks .
