REMOVE OLD TOILET


- 1. Shut off water supply line. If you do not have shut-off valve near the toilet shut off main water supply line.
- 2. Flush the old toilet and make sure that tank is empty.
- 3. Disconnect and remove water supply line connected to the toilet's tank.
- 4. Remove old toilet, bolts, nuts from the closet flange.
- 5. Clean closet flange area from old wax ring and putty sealant using putty knife from the base area.
- 6. Clean any remaining debris and wipe any water at the installation area
- 7. Temporarily plug flange on a floor with a flange plug or towel to prevent gasses from escaping






PREPARE CLOSET FLANGE

Make sure that rough-in is 12" by measuring the distance from the wall to the center of the closet flange. See Figure 1









Using template outline the area where the toilet will sit with pencil or tape to more easily locate flange bolts and make a solid connection between wax ring and flange when set. Make sure to remove template, leaving outline before installing. See Figure 4


Locate and remove template from carton. Place over toilet flange. Measure from back wall to make sure it is square/even with wall. Check your shut-off valve to make sure it clears back of template. *See Figure 3*

INSTALL WAX RING

Important: safety glasses must be worn by the installer and all bystanders.

Cover the floor with a soft-close blanket. Carefully turn the toilet on it's side or upside-down on the blanket with assistance of a second person. Install wax ring over the horn discharge located on the bottom of the toilet's bowl. See Figure 5

Note: Ceramic is a fragile material. You must always cover the floor with a soft-cloth blanket if you want to put the toilet on the floor on any side other than the bottom of the toilet. If you do not cover the floor with a soft-close blanket contact of the toilet with the floor may and will cause minor or moderate scratches on the toilet's surface.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

INSTALL NEW TOILET

Step 1. Lift and carefully put the toilet over the closet flange inside the outline made by template so the closet bolts can go through the mounting holes in the toilet's base. Once the bowl is in the position

holes in the toilet's base. Once the bowl is in the position press the bowl down with slight twisting motion in level position towards the floor. Apply your body weight to evenly compress the wax ring to create watertight seal. Make sure that the bowl is as leveled as possible to have a nice seal tight.

Do not rock the toilet back and forth and side to side as it may and will break a seal and you will need to replace the wax ring again and start the installation process over. See Figure 6

Step 2. Once the toilet is set and leveled install washers and nuts over the closet bolts. Tighten nuts. Do not overtighten the nuts. It may and will cause damage to the toilet's ceramic base. Please keep in mind that because this is a skirted trap-way toilet, it may require a little more time, patience and accessibility to complete install. See Figure 7

CONNECT TOILET'S TANK TO WATER SUPPLY LINE

Connect the water supply line between the tank and water shut-off valve using a toilet hose (not supplied). When connecting toilet hose tighten coupling nut to the tank by 1/4 turn beyond the hand tight.



Do not overtighten nut on the tank connection. It may and will cause water leakage.

Turn on valve on water supply line and allow tank to fill. Check all connections for leakages and tighten as needed.

Once tank is filled with water flush it 4-5 times to perform a test of the flushing system. At the same time check the bottom of the toilet for leaks to make sure that the wax ring is properly installed and sealed.

If there are no leaks you are ready finalize the installion. If any shims are installed at the bottom of the toilet's bowl you may trim them. Apply silicone around base of the toilet's. Allow 24 hours for silicone to dry before start using the toilet. *See Figure 8*

Important: Leaks may not occur during or right after the installation. Make sure to check for leaks every couple hours first day installed and and occasionally check it everyday for the next week to ensure that toilet is properly installed and no leaks occur. If any leaks occur immediately shut off the water supply line valve and contact your local plumber to fix all leaks.


1. PREPARATION

Remove the worn-out fittings and clean your tank prior to the installation of the new ones. There might be a lot of impurities in your tank that may cause damage to the new parts if you do not clean them out. The tank must be absolutely clean prior to installation.

MAINTENANCE & CARE

- 2. It is recommended to use water-proof electrical outlet which should be Installed in the place where is not easily got wet.
- 3. This product should be used with AC 110V-120V,50/60Hz electrical current only,load current is at least 15A. P ower plug must be equipped with ground fault circuit interrupter or ground fault electrical leakage protector or similar high sensitive, rapid type leakage switch (Rated sensitive current under 15mA).
- 4. When it thunders, it is strongly recommended to pull out the power plug.
- 5. Do not stand on ceramic toilet.
- 6. Ceramic toilet must install floor fixing bolt.
- 7. Do not stand on product unit, seat and cover.
- 8. Do not lean against the seat cover when using the product, to avoid damage.
- 9. This product is equipped with soft-closing seal cover. Heavy pressing or pushing may damage the soft-closing damper.
- 10. Do not use lacquer thinner, petrol, liquid medicine, detergent, insecticide, toilet cleanser and scrubbing brush to clean the product.
- 11.Exposure to direct sunlight is prohibited.
- 12. Only use tap water or potable water; otherwise it may cause chafing.
- 13.Do not connect water supply to heater outlet. Make sure inlet water temperature at 3~35°C
- 14. When the room temperature is under zero degree, please dry up the water tank, to avoid freezing.
- 15. Raise rest room temperature to prevent the toilet from damage due to freezing.
- 16. When move the product from cold or wet environment into normal room temperature, wait for 2 hours until the condensation water is fully volatilized. Doing so can prevent the product from electrical short-circuit.
- 17. When not using the product over three(3) days, drain the water out of the container and pull the elelctrical plug from the wall outlet.
- 18.Stop using the product and shut off the power when product malfunctions, please contact the service people for professional service.

GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

This product should be grounded. In the event of an electrical short circuit, grounding reduces the risk of electric shock by providing an escape wire for the electric current. 


Installation of Main Unit

- * This product has been tested for water flow before leaving the factory. There may be a small amount of residual water dripping out when removing the product, which is not a malfunction.
- * Do not install this product in a wet place such as a bathroom, and do not put it in a place prone to water.



Installation of Water inlet pipe and Tee joint



Connect Tee joint to angle valve; (The original Tee joint should be removed); Connect the inlet end of water supply pipe to Tee joint according to the above illustration; Connect main unit to Tee joint according to the above illustration.




Preparation for Start-Up

1. Turn on the angle valve

• Check the tightness of the threaded connection to ensure that there is no water leakage. Turn the angle valve counterclockwise to adjust the opening to the maximum.

(Tips: when the valve is opened for the first time, the angle valve handle has a large torque)




2. Power Connection

• Insert power line leakage protection plug into the power socket, press the reset switch, plug indicator lights on indicating that the power is on.

Tips:

Press electric leakage test button prior to usage, the reset switch pops up indicating that the leakage protection function is normal.

Press the TEST button (then RESET button) every month to assure proper operation.



3. Safety self-test

- 1. The main unit buzzer beeps once, and the knob (button) starts self-test after the white light flashes.
- 2. The main unit buzzer beeps again, and the self-test is completed, and the knob (button) lights up in white;
- 3. The function mode is turned on and in normal use.

Daily Maintenance

Maintenance of Main Unit

1. Turn off the power during maintenance of this machine.

2. Wipe the dirty area with a soft cloth that is wrung out of water.

3. After wiping, please turn on the power again.










Tips: Do not rinse the surface of the product directly with water during maintenance.





Maintenance of the Nozzle

When there is dirt on the nozzle, maintain it according to the following methods:

- 1. When no one is seated, turn the knob forward (press Rear Cleaning Button on the main unit), then nozzle rod is extended, and manually clean with a rag or soft brush.
- 2. Nozzle can be removed and cleaned separately. (Hold the nozzle rod in one hand and pull the nozzle out with the other hand)

3. Put back the nozzle, and then press the knob button (Stop button) on the main unit or the "Stop" button on the remote control, the guided rod retracts.






Tips: Do not pull the nozzle rod to prevent the damage of the nozzle rod and motor.

Filter Maintenance

Time for maintenance: It is under normal water pressure but poor flush performance occurs.

- 1. Turn off the angle valve.
- 2. Unscrew toilet water inlet pipe and seat water inlet pipe.
- 3. Take out filter and filter washer
- 4. Brush filter with toothbrush and clean filter
- 5. Re-install filter and filter washer, then re-install water inlet pipe






Self-cleaning Waterway Maintenance

Self-cleaning waterway maintenance: When the self-cleaning waterway is blocked, there is no water coming out during self-cleaning process.



Cut off power prior to discharging the water.


- 1. Turn off the angle valve.
- 2. Unplug the power plug, cut off the power.
- 3. Remove the seat, press current-limiting shaft in the middle with a flat-blade screwdriver, then reinstall the seat, and open the inlet valve.
- 4. If there is still no water coming out after pressing current-limiting shaft, use a flat-blade screwdriver to unscrew current-limiting nut, remove current-limiting shaft, and clean it with a toothbrush or small brush. After cleaning, replace current-limiting nut and current-limiting shaft to the restrictor In the device, then reinstall the seat, and open the inlet valve.

Deodorizing Device Maintenance

Unscrew the screws, take out the deodorant box, and replace the none-photocatalyst.

It is recommended to replace the none-photocatalyst after 3 years of use (the specific life span depends on the environment).




Removal and Installation of Clamp



Removal: Open the clamp c o v e r, r o t a t e i t counterclockwise, and use a flat-blade screwdriver to pry the clamp out of the slot.



Installation: Install the quick-released connector of water inlet pipe into the main unit, and clip the clamp into the slot



- b. The clamp is rotated until the opening faces down.
- c. Close the clamp cover
