WARNING (To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury to persons):

- 1. We suggest installation by a **licensed electrician**.
- 2. Please read the instruction carefully and save it as you may need it at later time.
- 3. Before you start, **NEVER** attempt any work without shutting off the electricity until the work is done. A). Go to the main fuse, or circuit breaker, box in your home. Place the main power switch in the "**OFF**" position. B). Place the wall switch in the "**OFF**" position.
- 4. Mounting surface should be clean, dry, flat, strong enough and 1/4" larger than the canopy on all side. Any gaps between the mounting surface and canopy exceeding 3/16" should be corrected as required.
- 5. Make sure that the ceiling or wall can stand the weight of the lamp before fixture.
- 6. Make sure the voltage you are using is **120V**. The maximum wattage is **40W** per bulb.
- 7. Keep the lamp away from acidic and basic objects in case of damaging the surface of the lamp.
- 8. When replacing bulb, you should turn off or unplug the lamp and you must wait until it is cool as bulbs get hot quickly.
- 9. The safety instructions appearing in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions that may occur. It must be understood that common sense, caution and care must be used with any electrical products.

### ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Carefully remove the fixture from the carton and check that all parts and accessories are included as shown in the above illustration
- 2. Make pre-installation



- Step A1: Thread the tubes (I)onto the top of cage(K) till snug.
- Step A2: By measuring, determine the correct number of links needed for proper hanging height. Using the chain pliers, disconnect and discard the remaining chain.
- Step A3: Open the quick link (G) to connect the loop on the top of tube (J) and the chain (H), Close the quick link (G).
- Open another quick link (G) to connect the loop at the bottom of canopy (E) and the chain (H), Close the quick link (G).
- Step A4: Carefully lace the wires through the chain (H)(every other link)and stop just before you reach the top of canopy (E). Gently pull the wires till snug.
- Step A5: If needed, cut off the wires length of fixture. At this point, the remaining wire length measured from the top of canopy should be at least 6".

### 3. Turn off power

Before you start to make installation, NEVER attempt any work without shutting off the electricity until the work is done. A). Go to the main fuse, or circuit breaker, box in your home. Place the main power switch in the "OFF" position. B). Place the wall switch in the "OFF" position

### 4. Make installation



Step B1: Attach the mounting plate (A) to outlet box with mounting screws (D). The side of mounting plate marked "GND" must face out.

Step B2: Make wire connections

Connect wires as below wires connecting shown. TAKE NOTE OF YOUR COLOR OF FIXTURE ,NEVER CONNECT

### WIRES TO GROUND WIRES

Twist plastic wire connector until wires are tightly joined together, wrap each connector with approved electrical tape. Be sure that no wire strands are exposed and then carefully tuck all wires into the outlet box .

Step B3: Align the holes in the canopy (E) with the mounting screws, then attach the canopy (E) using the previously removed ball knobs(H). Hand tighten until snug.

Note: The canopy (E) should be snug against the ceiling and the mounting balls. If not, adjust the length of the nipples on the mounting plate assembly (A) by unscrewing the pre-assembled hex nuts and then screwing the mounting screws in or out of the mounting plate until the length is achieved. Hand tighten the hex nuts and proceed to step B3

Step B4: Install bulbs (not included) (Please do not exceed the maximum capacity recommended on the socket.)

5. Check everything is already installed properly, then you could turn on the light. Enjoy!

# CLEANING

To clean, wipe fixture with a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive materials such as scouring pads or powders, steel wool or abrasive paper.
