

# How to connect Eaton's EV smart breaker charger with the EV Charger Manager app

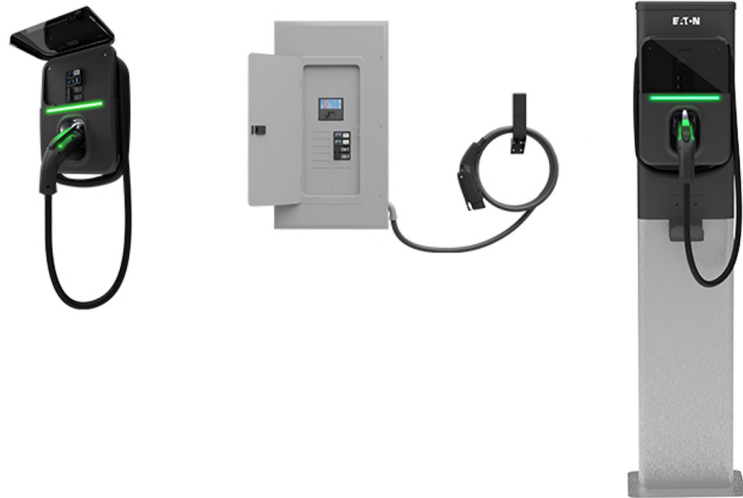
## Step 1

### Install EV charger

Ensure that the EV charger is installed and powered up.

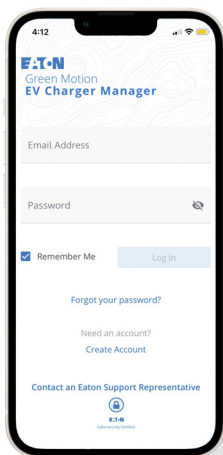
Refer to the instructions in the box.

**Always use a qualified electrician.**

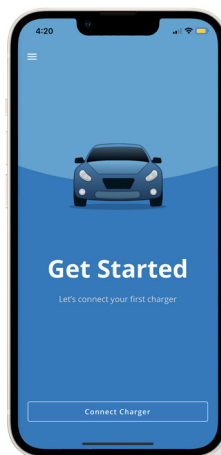


## Step 2

### Download app and create account



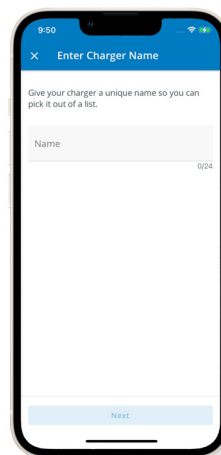
Download the EV Charger Manager app on the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.



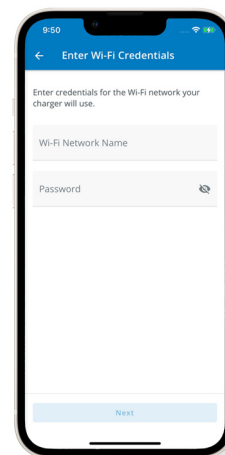
Create an account and verify it with an active email address.  
Log in at home page.

## Step 3

### Create Home & Enter Wi-Fi credentials



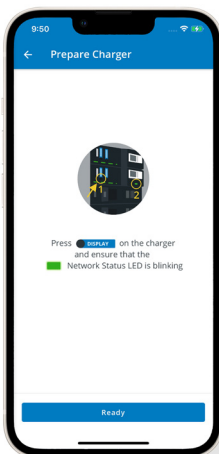
Enter a name for your EV charger.



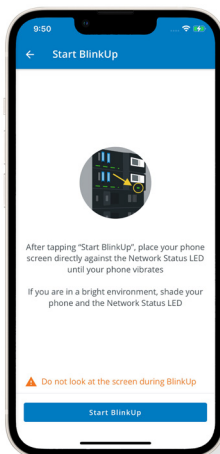
Type in your Wi-Fi credentials.

## Step 4

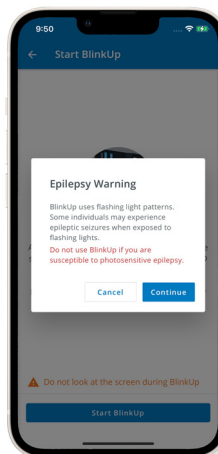
### Enable BlinkUp



On the EV smart breaker charger, press the "DISPLAY" button and ensure that the Network Status LED is blinking. If it is, then touch the "READY" button on your phone.



After reading the instructions on the phone, touch the "START BLINKUP" button.

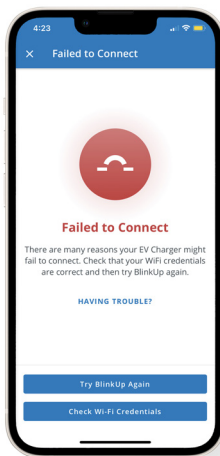
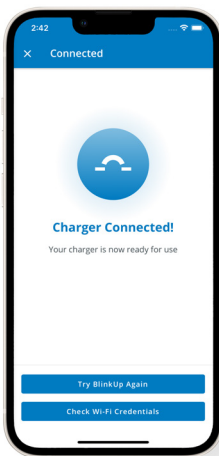


After reading the Warning message, touch "CONTINUE", then place your phone's screen AGAINST the Network Status LED on the EV smart breaker charger until your phone vibrates and beeps.

**Note:** Do NOT look at the screen during BlinkUp. This should take no more than 90 seconds.

## Step 5

### Connection Complete



Once the BlinkUp process is complete, you will be notified when the device is successfully connected to the Wi-Fi network.

You should now see the device in the app.

**Note:** In the case your breaker does not connect, review the troubleshooting information.

- Check you entered the correct Wi-Fi credentials
- Ensure your phone is touching the breaker during BlinkUp
