

- Not for permanent installation
- Suitable for outdoor use (or indoor)
- Only used on horizontal surfaces
- Maximum top/bottom weight load of 300 LBS
- Maximum middle shelf weight load of 200 LBS
- Maximum cabinet bottom weight load of 200 LBS
- Before use, make sure the height of the wheels is adjusted so that the table does not wobble while in use.
- Lock the wheels before use.
- Be careful with all electric appliances, tools, extension cords and lights on and around table.
- Surface will become hot in direct sun or high temperatures. Please touch carefully to avoid burns.
- Do not allow children to climb the product.

Care and Maintenance

CLEANING

Painted and Plastic Surface


Wash with mild detergent or non-abrasive cleaner and warm Water.

Stainless Steel Surface

Wash with mild detergent and warm soapy water or use stainless steel cleaner. Wipe dry with a soft cloth after each use.

Wash only in the direction of the stainless brushed finish to avoid damage.

Stainless steel can rust under certain conditions. This can be caused by acidic marinades, chlorine, saltwater, exposure to coastal climates, other natural elements, or improper cleaning tools such as wire or steel wool.



When assembling, partially thread one screw into its corresponding position on one side, securing it temporarily (be careful not to fully tighten).


Proceed to do the same for the other locations following a similar approach until all screws for this step are correctly aligned with their threads.





Once this step is completed, proceed to fully tighten all screws.

If you encounter misalignment with any screws, gently apply manual pressure to slightly adjust the hole to align it with the desired position before threading the screw into the thread.

Once the screw is in place, release the pressure.

Following these steps will allow you to continue with the tightening process

1. Insert E into the hole on (18) (front corner of (18))


2. Place (16) & (16A) into the position

3. Hold (17), insert from the top inside of door.




Install 16B onto 16A (inside), using B x 6.

Slide in 5, using F & G & H to secure on the rail (1 pairs).






STEP 13

Install (1) onto the assembled cart, using A x 8.


NOTE: Logo face to front



Please align the holes, install a corner at first and do not tighten the 8-screws at the 4-corners.


Special Reminder: when installing the 2nd to 4th corners, the holes may not be aligned.


Solution: one person can pull the top plate outward to align the holes.



STEP 14

Attach (11) onto front of (9), using A x 2.










STEP 15


Attach tools holder (2) onto left side of counter top, using 2pcs Bolt M6 x 12(A)

NOTE: Please do not tighten the screw right now!

Insert washer (D) at the middle of holder, line the hole, using 1pcs Bolt M6 x 25 (C) to secure the washer.

PLEASE tighten all three bolts at this time







STEP 16

Pre-assemble bolt A x 2 onto (9).

DO NOT TIGHTEN THE BOLT

Hang (7) on those pre-assemble bolt, then secure the tray by another A x 2.

Finally, tighten all 4 bolts!




STEP 17

Pre-assemble bolt A x 2 onto (10).

DO NOT TIGHTEN THE BOLT

Hang (12) on those pre-assemble bolt, then secure the cart handle by another A x 2.

Finally, tighten all 4 bolts!







Install (21) x 2 onto (9) and (20).

Please install in a bright place or use lighting.

Suggest to use the middle position hole.



-Cutting board can use for shelf, also can be taken out to prepare food




Attach (22) on right side door, there a reset holder located inside of (16) .


Put (13) x 4 on (12) .




