Light

I like bright, indirect light where I cast a strong shadow at least a couple of hours a day, but don't mind medium light

Water

I don't want my roots to stay wet, so let the top inch or two of the potting soil dry before you water me again.

Food

I don't need a lot of fertilizer, so you can feed me once or twice in spring and/or summer. You can feed me more often if you want me to grow faster.

Features

I'm one of the most common houseplants around thanks to my easy-growing nature. I am drought-tolerant and purify the air.

Growing tips

Wipe the leaves down once or twice a month to prevent dust build up. Snake plants don't like wet feet and can suffer from root rot if too much water builds up.
