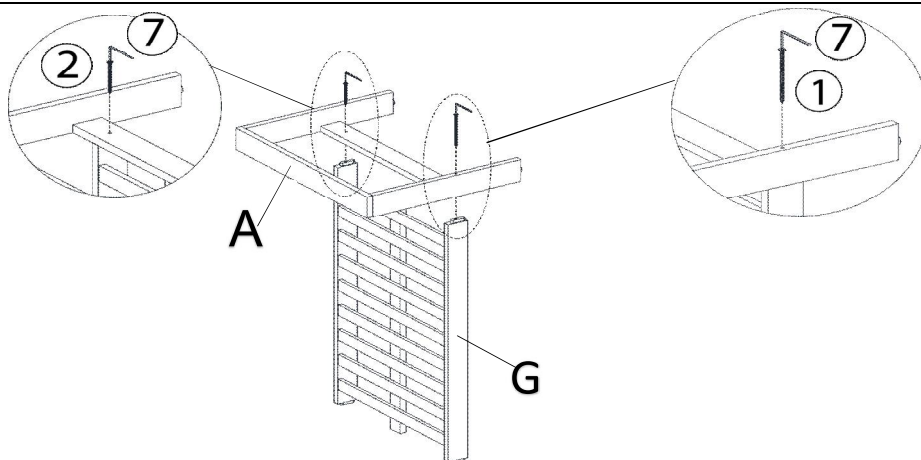

To give you an overview of the 3 Seater parts, the above picture is provided to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2

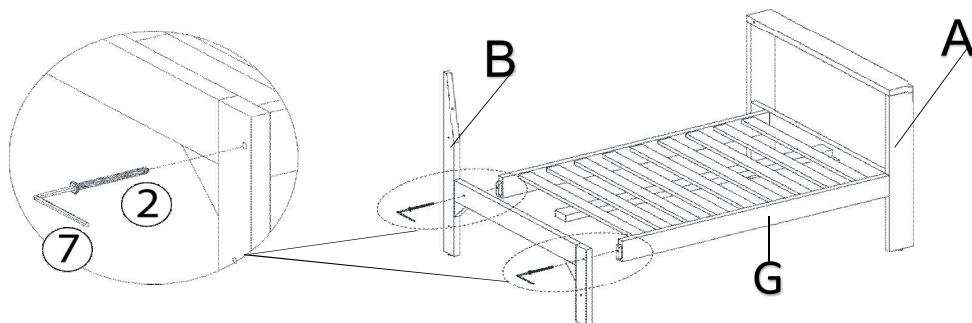


Place the Right Seat Panel (G) upright as shown in the picture above onto a clean, soft surface to avoid any scratches or damage to the product.

With assistance from your adult partner(s), attach the Right Leg Panel (A) to the Right Seat Panel (G) using Screws (1), Screws (2) and the Allen Wrench (7) as pictured

Do not fully tighten the Screws at this time.

Step 3

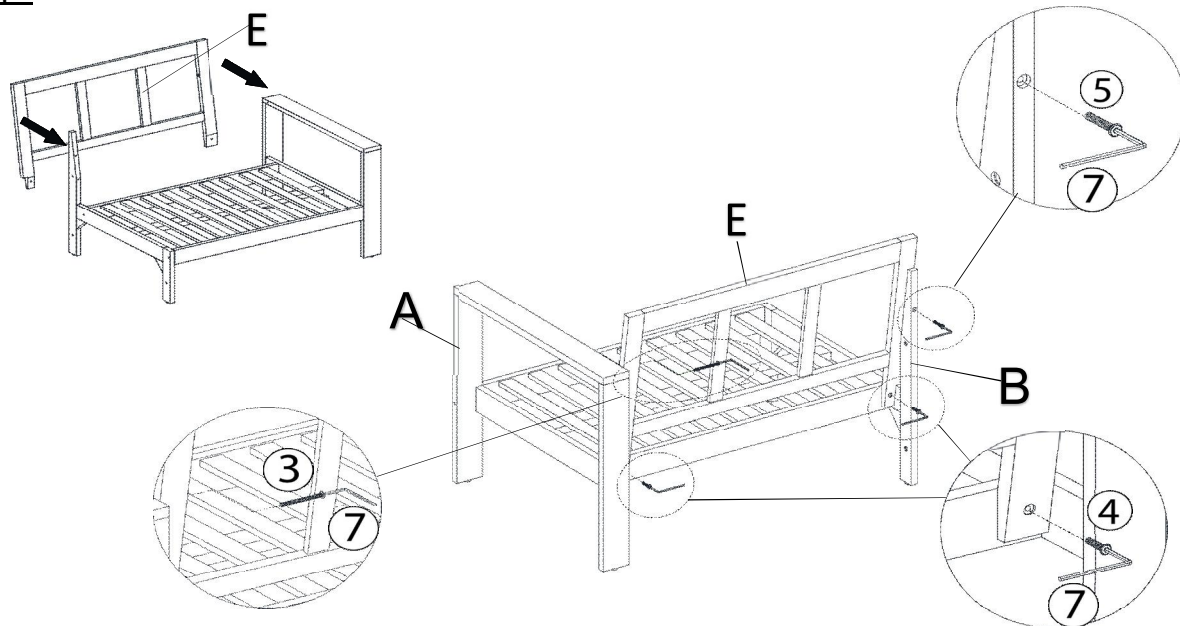


Stand the Chair frame up as pictured: With assistance from your adult partner(s)

Attach the Right Middle Leg panel (B) to the assembled parts in Step 2 by using Screws (2) and the Allen Wrench (7) as shown above.

DO NOT fully tighten the Screws at this time.

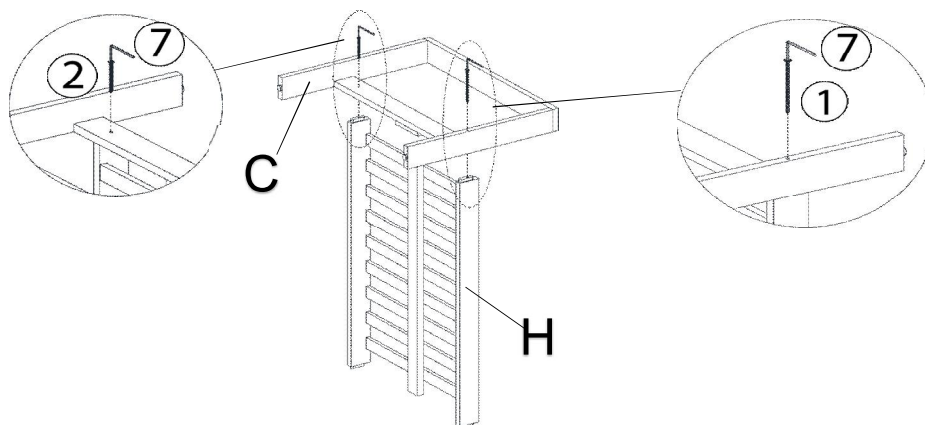
Step 4



With assistance from your adult partner(s), attach the Right Backrest Panel (E) to the assembled frame in step 3 by using Bolts (③), Bolts (④), Bolts (⑤) and the Allen Wrench (⑦) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

Step 5

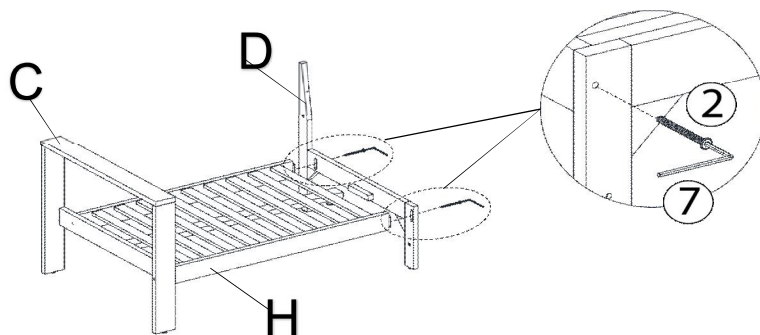


Place the Left Seat Panel (H) upright as shown in the picture above onto a clean, soft surface to avoid any scratches or damage to the product.

With assistance from your adult partner(s), attach the Left Leg Panel (C) to the Left Seat Panel (H) using Screws (①), Screws (②) and the Allen Wrench (⑦) as pictured

Do not fully tighten the Screws at this time.

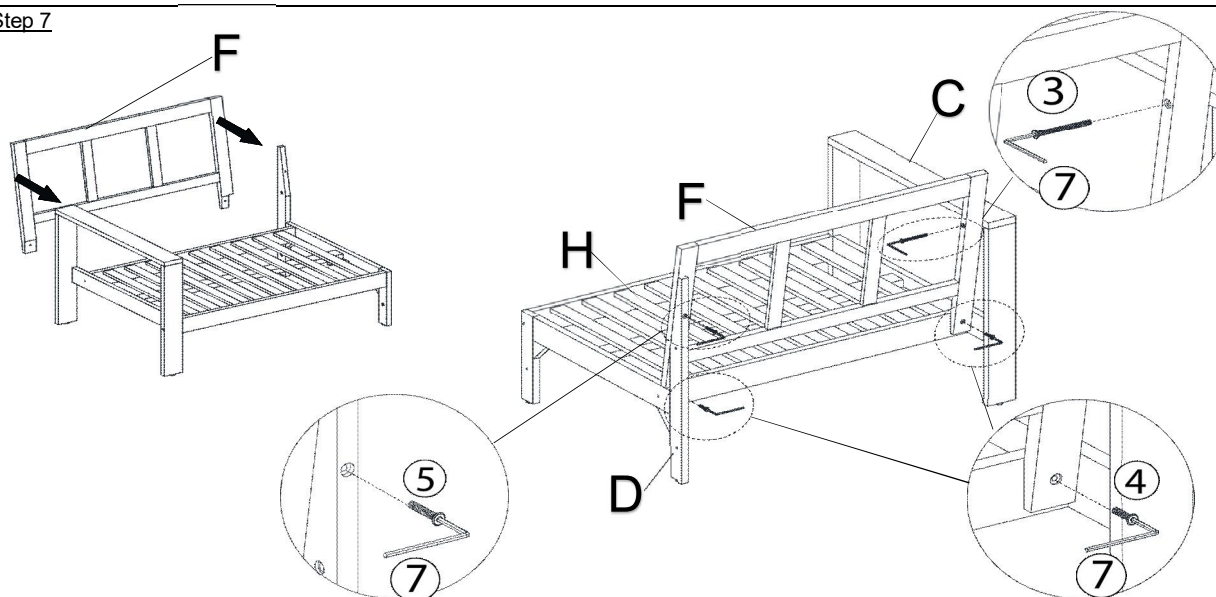
Step 6



Stand the Chair frame up as pictured: With assistance from your adult partner(s)
Attach the Left Middle Leg Panel (D) to the assembled parts in Step 5 by using Screws (②) and the Allen Wrench (⑦) as shown above.

DO NOT fully tighten the Screws at this time.

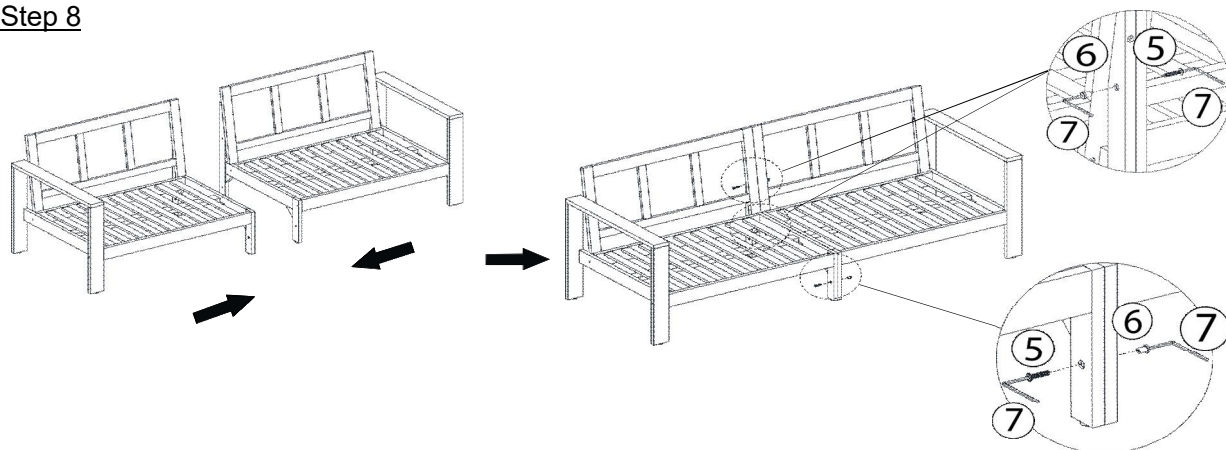
Step 7



With assistance from your adult partner(s), attach the Left Backrest Panel (F) to the assembled frame in step 6 by using Bolts (③), Bolts (④), Bolts (⑤) and the Allen Wrench (⑦) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

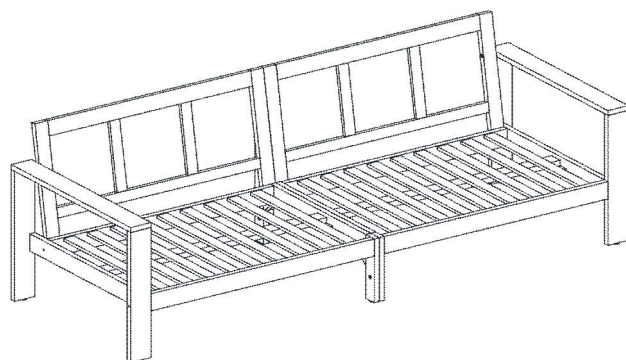
Step 8



With assistance from your adult partner(s): place 2 (two) Chair frame stand up and connect the Chairs together by using Bolts (⑤), Sleeve Nut(⑥) and the Allen Wrench (⑦) as shown above.

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

Step 8



Turn the 3 Seater right side up.

Inspect the 3 Seater and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

In a sequential manner, tighten all Screws and Bolts at all joints.

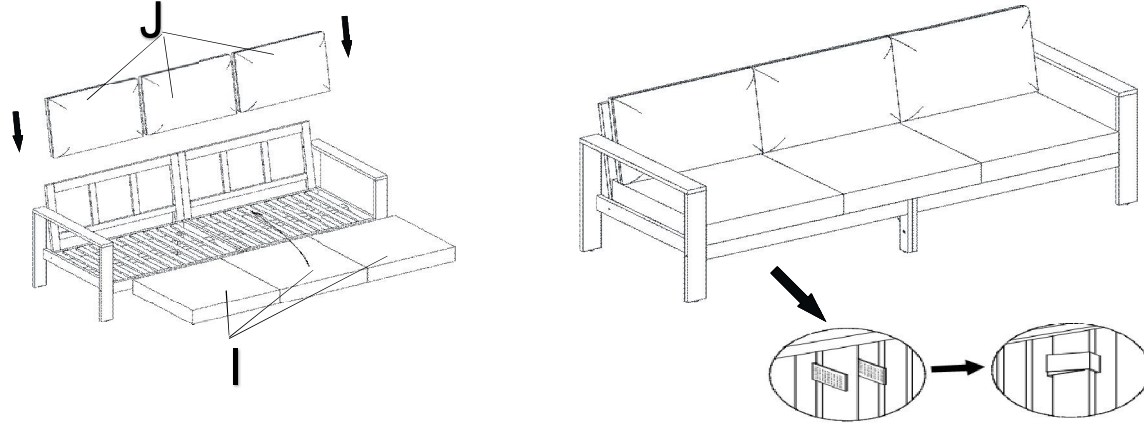
Place the Chair on a flat, level surface to make sure it is balance

CAUTION: When tightening these screws and bolts, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any screw or bolt fully and then move towards the next one. This could cause the frame to warp.

Step 9



Place 3 Seat Cushion (I), and 3 Back Cushions (J) onto the 3 Seater.

Then affix the "magic tape straps" around the 3 Seater as shown above.

Your 3 Seater is ready to be used.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

• What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.

Step 1

Step 2

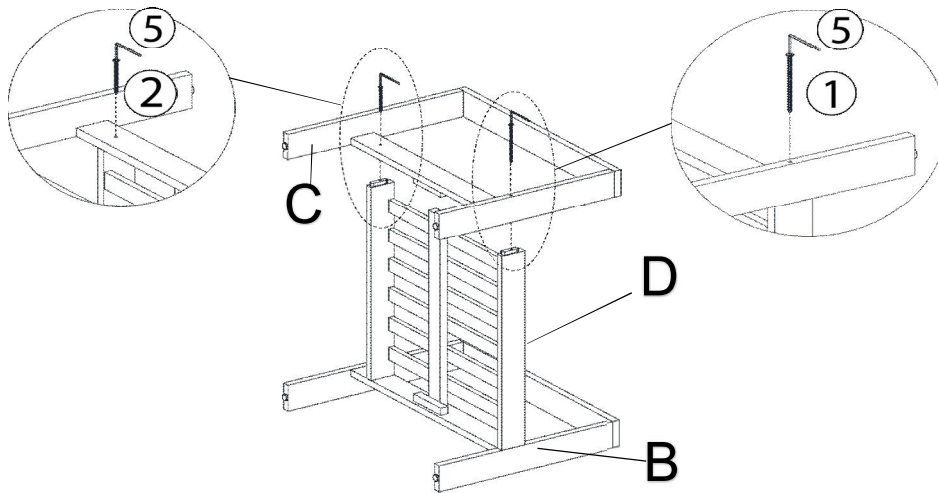


Place the Seat Panel (D) upright as shown in the picture above onto a clean, soft surface to avoid any scratches or damage to the product.

With assistance from your adult partner(s), attach the Right Leg Panel (B) to the Seat Panel (D) using Screws (①), Screws (②) and the Allen Wrench (⑤) as pictured

Do not fully tighten the Screws at this time.

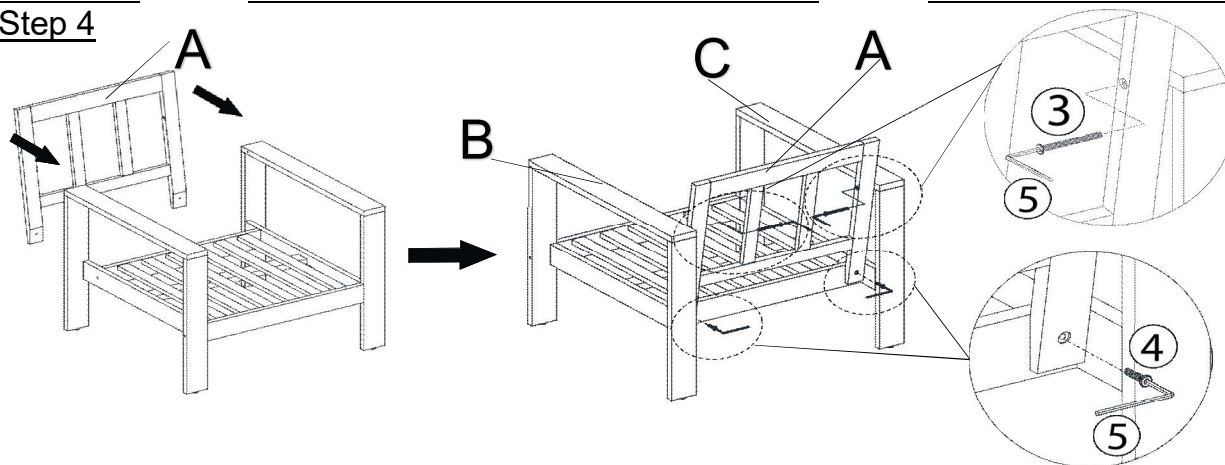
Step 3



With assistance from your adult partner(s), attach the Left Leg Panel (C) to the assembled parts in Step 2 using Screws (①), Screws (②) and the Allen Wrench (⑤) as pictured

Do not fully tighten the Screws at this time.

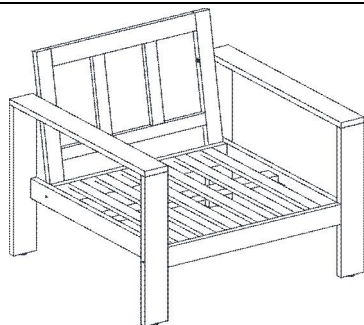
Step 4



With assistance from your adult partner(s), attach the Backrest Panel (A) to the assembled frame in step 3 by using Bolts (③), Bolts (④) and the Allen Wrench (⑤) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

Step 5



Turn the chair right side up.

Inspect the chair and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

In a sequential manner, tighten all Screws and Bolts at all joints.

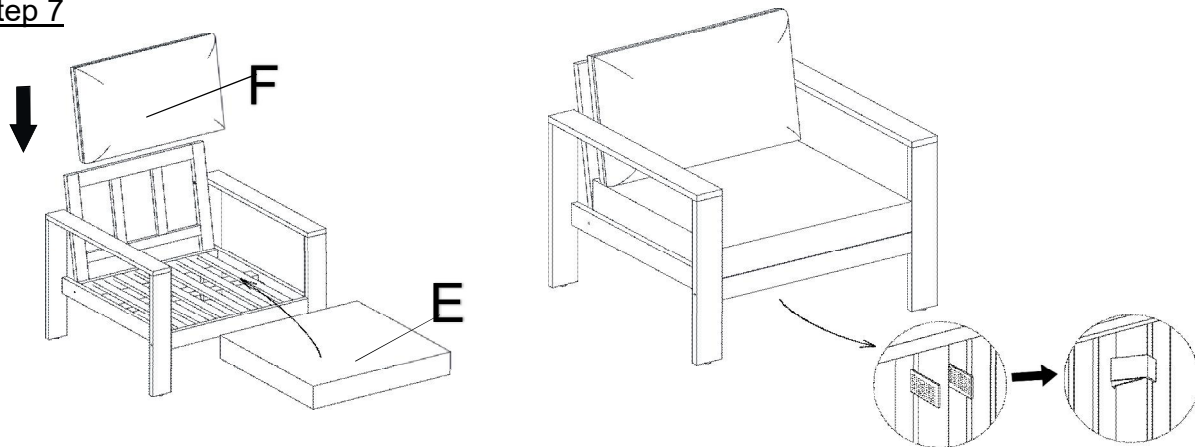
Place the Chair on a flat, level surface to make sure it is balance

CAUTION : When tightening these screws and bolts, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any screw or bolt fully and then move towards the next one. This could cause the frame to warp.

Place the Seat Cushion (E), then the Back Cushion (F) into the Chair, and affix the velcro straps around the Chair as shown above.

Step 1



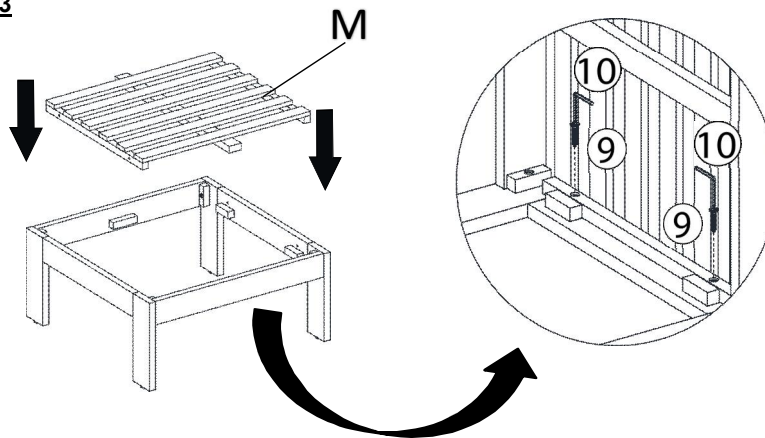
Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2



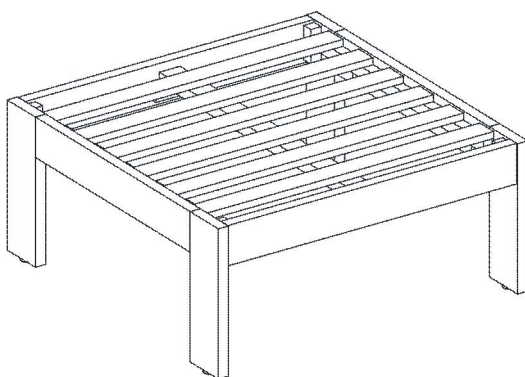
Place the Leg Panel(K) facedown as pictured above.
Insert the tenons on Side Panels(L) into the mortises of the Leg Panel(K).
Attach the Side Panels(L) to the Leg Panel(K) using Bolts(8) with Allen Wrench(10).
Repeat the same process with the remaining the Leg Panel(K).
Do not fully tighten the Bolts

Step 3



Insert the Seat Panel(M) into assembled Ottoman frame as pictured above.
Attach the Seat Panel(M) to the Side Panels(L) using Screws(9) with Allen Wrench(10).
Note: Insert Screws(9) from inside to outside of Seat Panel(M).
Do not fully tighten the Screws.

Step 4



Place the Ottoman onto a flat, level surface.

Then EXERT pressure, floorwards onto the Ottoman with both hands.

This pressure will help the Ottoman reach full alignment at all joints.

In a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Bolts and Screws at all joints until evenly secured.

Inspect the Ottoman and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

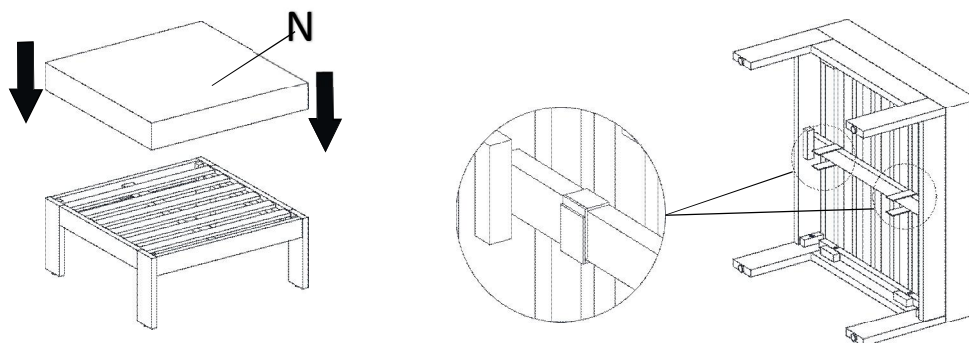
Place the Ottoman on a flat, level surface to make sure it is balance

CAUTION : When tightening these screws and bolts, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any screw or bolt fully and then move towards the next one. This could cause the frame to warp.

WARNING!! IF THE OTTOMAN IS NOT STABLE , IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.

Step 5



Place the Seat Cushion (N) to the Seat Panel (M).

Then affix the "magic tape straps" around the Ottoman as shown above.

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Ensure all screws, bolts are fully locked into position and secured.

The OTTOMAN is ready to be used.

CAUTION: This Ottoman can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2

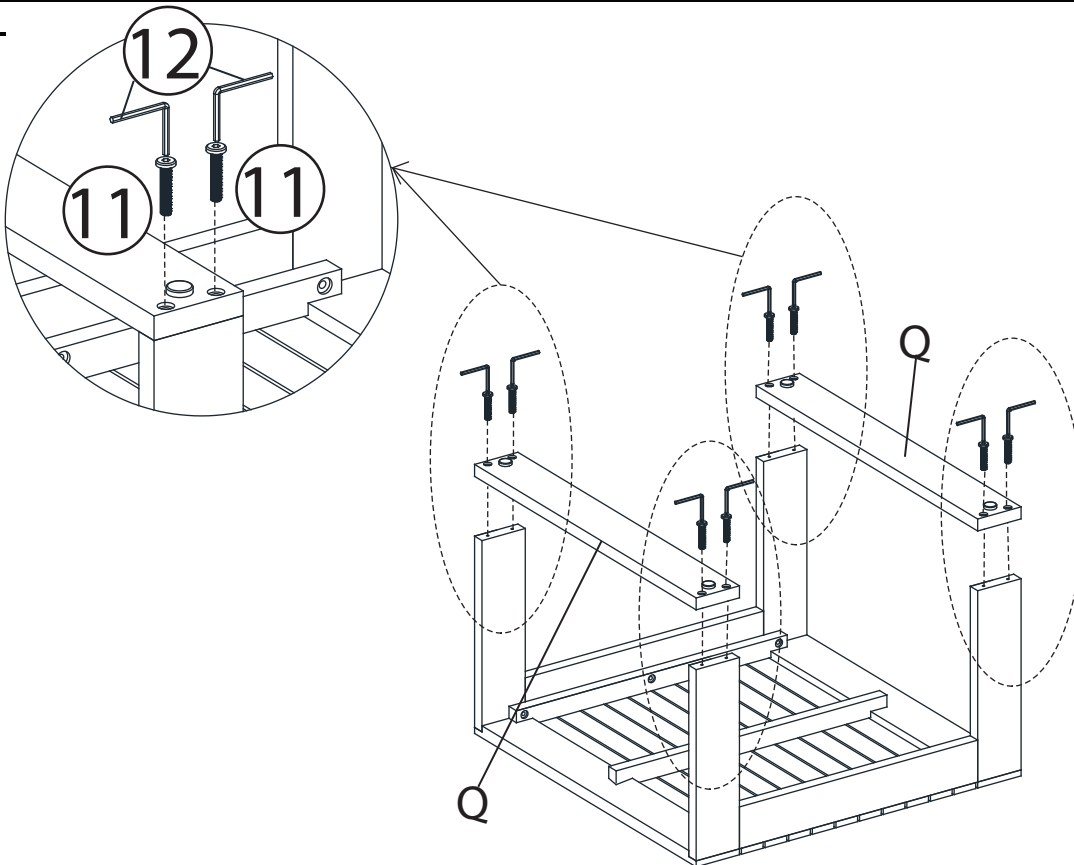


Turn the Table top (O) up side down as shown in picture above.

Attach the Leg Panel (P) to Table top (O) by using Bolts (11), and Allen Wrench (12) as shown in picture above.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

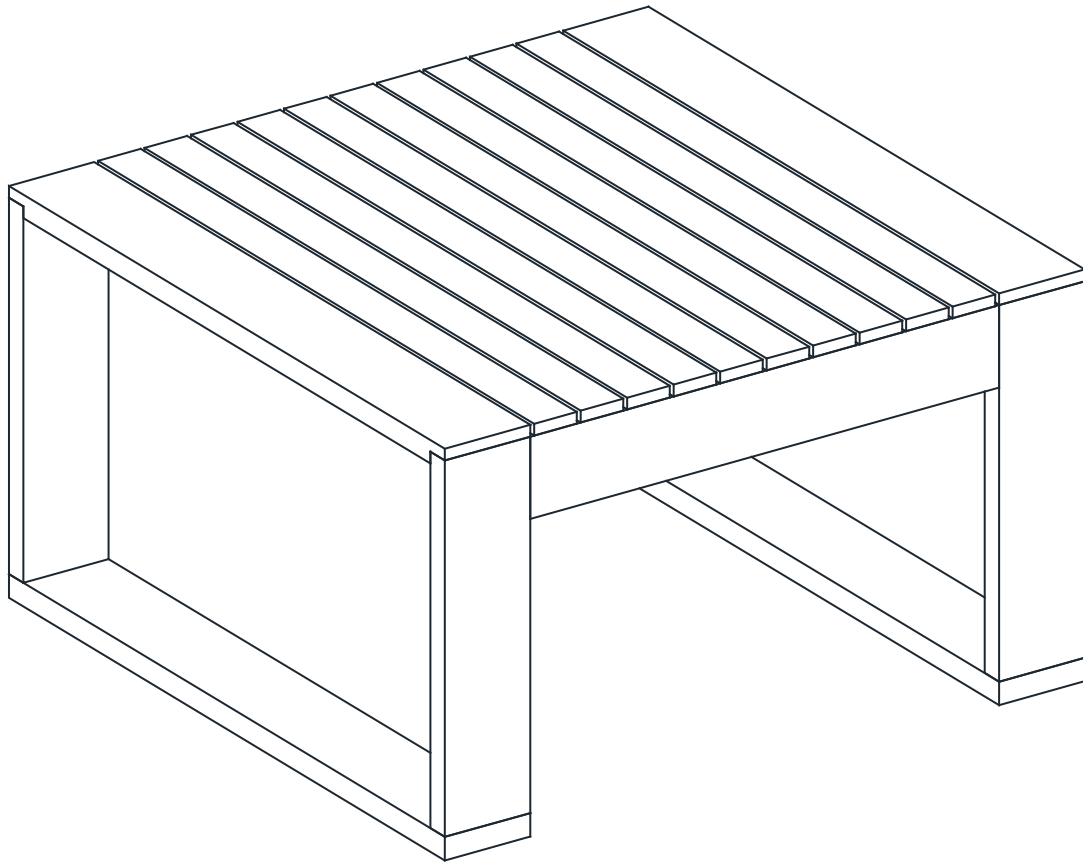
Step 3



Attach the Base Leg (Q) to into the frame of step 2 by using Bolts (11), and Allen Wrench (12) as shown in picture above.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 4



Turn the Table back to normal flat ground

EXERT pressure, floorwards, onto the Table.

This pressure will help the Legs and Table Top reach alignment at all joints.

Check for wobbles.

CAUTION : When tightening these screws and bolts, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any screw or bolt fully and then move towards the next one. This could cause the frame to warp.
