



Muscari is available in over 40 species and display massive bursts of color when planted in large groups in borders, rock gardens, under trees or in open areas. Muscari is easily grown in average, well-drained soil with fragrant flowers emerging in early to mid spring. Its flower spikes are said to resemble a bunch of grapes. Narrow, strap-shaped leaves appear in spring just before flowering.

About This Variety: Muscari Siberian Tiger® is a newer, award-winning variety whose blooms start out lime green and turn into white as it matures. It produces dense florets, but its strap-like foliage is not as pronounced as its cousin, Muscari armeniacum. Muscari produces spikes of fragrant, bell-shaped blooms. It is rodent resistant, naturalizes easily. Muscari is a good choice for mass plantings, borders, pots or make excellent cut flowers.

Growing Instructions: To ensure optimal results: allow adequate space, sunlight, plant at the appropriate depth, feed with a well balanced fertilizer and allow the leaves to die back before removing. For an informal look, plant in groups in natural swathes.

Care Tip: Plant in well draining soil. After planting, water well to settle the bulbs.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade *Height:* Grows 6-8" tall *Spacing:* Plant 3-4" apart, 5" deep *USDA Zones:* Hardy in USDA zones 4-9
