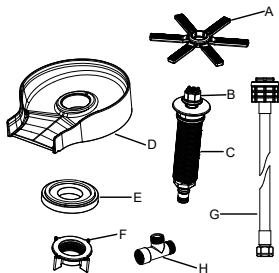

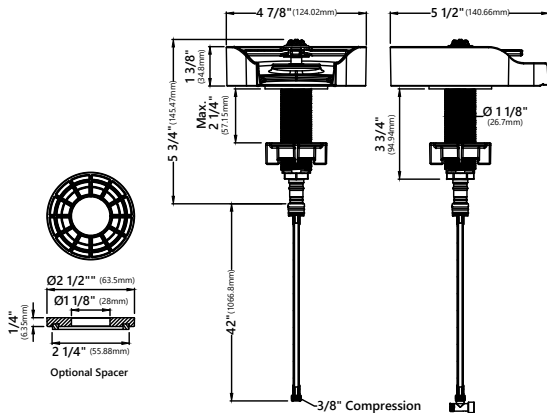

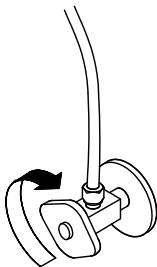
- A. Actuator

Dimensions



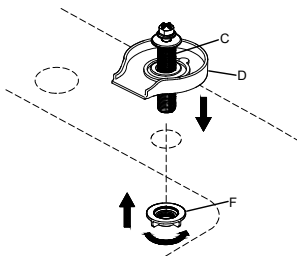
Step 1.

Turn off hot and cold water supplies at angle stops.



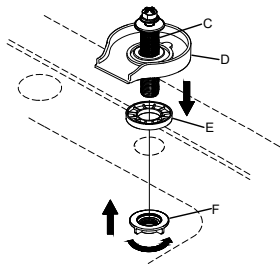
Step 2a.

Slide the mounting shank (C) through the base (D) from above. Lower this assembly through the sink from above. Ensure the base is aligned with the sink and the outlet extends into the sink basin prior to fully tightening the mounting nut (F) from below. For sinks with raised ledges, please follow step 2b instead.



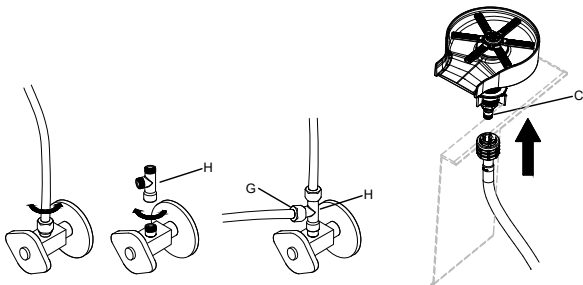
Step 2b.

Sinks with raised ledges may require the optional washer (E). Slide the mounting shank (C) through the base (D) and washer (E) from above. Lower this assembly through the sink from above. Ensure the base is aligned with the sink and the outlet extends into the basin prior to fully tightening mounting nut (F) from below.



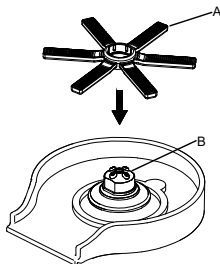
Step 3.

Determine whether you wish for your new glass rinser to be supplied by cold or hot water. Unthread the existing faucet supply line from the angle stop on the chosen side. Thread the provided tee (H) onto angle stop in place of the supply line that was disconnected in the previous step. Thread both the faucet supply line and the 3/8" end of provided supply line (G) to the tee. Connect the quick connect end of the provided supply line to the mounting shank (C) by snapping in. When the supply line is installed, check the alignment and retighten the mounting nut.



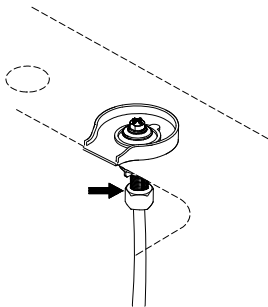
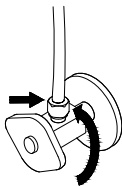
Step 4.

Align the locating features on the actuator arms (A) with those on the nozzle (B) and press the actuator arms firmly into place on the nozzle, oriented so the arms angle downward from the center. As needed, the actuator arms can be removed for cleaning.

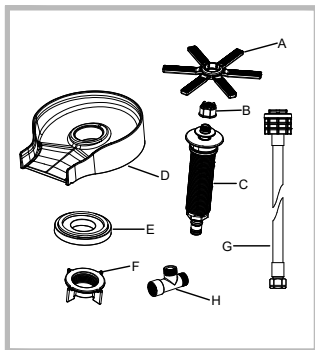


Step 5.

Turn on both water supplies at the angle stops and check for leaks at all connections made during this installation.
