IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING

- 1. Use appliance only for its intended use.
- 2. To protect against a risk of electric shock, do not immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.
- 3. The appliance should always be turned to "Off" before plugging or unplugging from outlet. Never yank cord to disconnect from outlet; instead, grasp plug and pull to disconnect.
- 4. Do not allow cord to touch hot surfaces. Let appliance cool completely before putting away. Loop cord loosely around appliance when storing.
- 5. Always disconnect appliance from electrical outlet when filling with water or emptying and when not in use.
- 6. Do not operate appliance with a damaged cord or if the appliance has been dropped or damaged. - During use, the steam generator should not be moved Never unscrew the steam generator cap while the appliance is plugged into the mains. The ironing system must be used on a stable ironing board.

- If the ironing system is dropped causing visible damage to the appliance (boiler or iron), do not use. Take to an authorised service centre.
- The steam generator should be placed on a flat surface extremely resistant to high temperatures.

USEFUL TIPS

- The original appearance and softness of fabrics such as velvet or wool, or gloves, bags etc. can be restored by passing the iron a short distance away with the steam jet in operation.
- To remove the marks left by furniture and restore carpets to new, allow the steam to penetrate into the flattened pile and brush lightly.
- Do not rest or use the iron on zips, hooks, rings etc to avoid scratching the plate.
- Keep the surface of the plate clean. To clean, when cold, wipe the surface with a damp cloth.
- The iron must never be treated with descaling products.
- During use, the iron can be rested in a "vertical" position (fig. 3). Make sure the surface is level to avoid the iron falling over.
- After use, always wait for the iron to cool down before putting away.
- Store the iron in a dry place. 0
- After ironing, the water remaining in the steam generator need not be drained.

However, the appliance should be drained of water if left unused for long periods.

- Separate clothes according to the recommended ironing temperature and begin ironing with items requiring the lowest temperatures.
- Silk may be dry-pressed on the reverse.
- Wool, cotton and fine linen can either be steam-ironed on the reverse or on the right side, interposing a thin cloth between the iron and the fabric to avoid "shine".
- Starched fabrics require greater moisture.
- Iron whites and light colours on the right side and dark colours on the reverse. Embroidery should also be ironed on the reverse to make it stand out.
- Linen can be steam-ironed with abundant steam. Iron dark colours on the reverse to avoid "shine".
- Iron lapels on the right side to make them stand out.
- Each time the iron is used (including for the first 0 time) or if you have not used the steam for several minutes, press the steam button several times away from the ironing board.
- This will eliminate cold water from the steam circuit.

INSTRUCTIONS

Preparing for ironing

This should always be done with the appliance cold and unplugged from the mains.

In this iron, the position of the steam/cable tube can be adapted to all working positions. If you want change the position, follow these instructions:

- lift the removable iron rest (5);
- turn the tube clamps outwards using a coin (fig.
- extract the tube and position it on the opposite 0 side, rotating it from the back of the control panel to avoid the internal cables twisting (fig.
- fix by turning the clamps with a coin. Unless the tube clamps are correctly closed, the iron rest cannot be positioned correctly.

never rest the iron on the appliance unless the iron rest is in position.

STEAM IRONING

Before steam ironing, make sure the fabric is suitable for this kind of ironing. The machine works with normal tap water. In case of very hard water (hardness above 27°F) we suggest using 50% distilled water diluted with tap water. Never use chemical substances or detergents (eg perfumed water, essences, descaling solutions, etc).

Filling the steam generator and connecting to the mains

Make sure the power cable is unplugged from the mains socket. Unscrew the steam generator cap (7) and fill the tank with water using the funnel (10). Screw up the cap (7) fully and plug the iron into the mains socket.

Important: never unscrew the cap (7) with the boiler under pressure.

Operation

Press the switch
(13) to turn on power to the steam generator. The "steam generator on" light (11) comes on. Press the switch = (15) to turn on power to the iron. The "iron on temperature" light (4) only comes on when the iron is at the ideal temperature and ready for use. The model is fitted with a steam regulation knob (14) enabling the quantity of steam to be increased or decreased. NB: When you turn the iron on, you are recommended to turn the steam regulation knob to the maximum steam position. NB: When Steam is used for the first time, it is normal if a few drops of water drip out of the iron. This may occur each time the iron is turned on after a prolonged cool down. NB: When used for the first time, the appliance may give off smoke and an odour for several minutes. This is caused by heating and subsequent drying of the sealers used in assembling the steam generator and iron. The room should be ventilated.

Position the thermostat regulation knob (3) in the area indicated in figure 4 according to the type of fabric to be ironed (fig. 6). Before ironing, wait until the "iron at temperature" light (4) goes off and the "steam ready" or ight (12) comes on. NB: both lights will go on and off during ironing, according to the temperature reached by the steam generator and iron. This is part of normal operation and is not a cause for concern.

TOPPING UP THE STEAM GENERATOR WITH WATER Turn the steam generator off using the switch (13). Vent any steam left using the button (2) or (2A) on the handle of the iron. Turn the iron off using the switch (15). Unplug from the mains socket. Unscrew the cap slowly and fill as described in the paragraph "filling the steam generator". DRY IRONING Plug the appliance into the mains. Press the switch 2 (15) to turn power to the iron on. The light (4) comes on. Position the thermostat regulation knob (3), according to the type of fabric to be ironed (fig.5). NB: When the iron has reached the selected temperature, the light (4) goes out. **AFTER IRONING** Wait for the appliance to cool down then position the iron rest on the appliance (models with removable iron rest only). Wrap the cable around the cable winder (8). Subject to changes

This device allows a continuous output of steam to be obtained by keeping the steam button pressed down mechanically, avoiding the need to do so manually. To use, simply press the button (2) and slide the lock backwards. To release the button, slide the lock forwards. IMPORTANT: the tube connecting the iron to the steam generator may become hot. When the water in the steam generator has run out, no more steam is given off. To refill, proceed as follows:

What does the warranty cover?

We warrant each appliance to be free from defects in material and workmanship. Our obligation under this warranty is limited to repair at our factory or authorized service center of any defective parts or part thereof, other than parts damaged in transit. In the event of a products replacement or return, the unit must be returned transportation prepaid. The repaired or new model will be returned at the company expense.

This warranty shall apply only if the appliance is used in accordance with the factory directions, which accompany it, and on an Alternating current (AC) circuit.

How long does the coverage last?

This warranty runs for three years (3) from the purchase date found on your receipt and applies only to the original purchaser for use.

What is not covered by the warranty?

The warranty does not cover defects or damage of the appliance, which result from repairs or alterations to the appliance outside our factory or authorized service centers, nor shall it apply to any appliance, which has been subject to abuse, misuse, negligence or accidents. Also, consequential and incidental damage resulting from the use of this product or arising out of any breach of contract or breach of this warranty are not recoverable under this warranty. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damage, so the above limitation may not apply to you.
