Read all instructions before using this appliance.

DANGER

To reduce the risk of electric shock:

- Do not reach for Groomer while plugged in that has fallen into water. Unplug immediately.
- Use Groomer only in dry condition. Do not use Groomer while bathing or in a shower.
- Do not submerge Groomer in water.

 Do not place or store Groomer where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink. Do not place or drop Groomer into water or other
- liquid while plugged in.

 Always unplug the Groomer from the electrical outlet immediately after use, except when Groomer is (re)charging.
 Remove power supply cord from Groomer
- before cleaning.
- When discarding Groomer, unplug Groomer before removing rechargeable batteries. See Battery Removal instructions.

WARNING

To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock or injury to persons:

- Close supervision is necessary when this Groomer is used by, on, or near children or
- Use this Groomer for its intended household use as described in this manual. Do not use attachments not recommended by Philips Electronics North America Corporation.

- Always attach plug to Groomer first, then charging plug into outlet. To disconnect, remove charging plug from outlet.
 Use only the cord provided to charge and
- (re)charge the Groomer.

 11. If the appliance is subjected to a major
- change in temperature, pressure or humidity, let the appliance acclimatize for
- 30 minutes before using.

 12. Never put the Groomer in direct sunlight or store at a temperature above 140°F.
- To prevent possible damage to the cord, do not wrap cord around the Groomer.
- Only use the power plug and other accessories supplied with the Groomer.



Put It To The Test

Like many new products, your Philips Norelco Grooming Kit may take a little getting used to. If you are using an electric Groomer for the first time, or if you've been using a different brand, take the time to acquaint yourself with your new Grooming Kit.

Your Grooming Kit features a full size trimmer with all the attachments to make trimming facial hairs or hair clipping goof proof.

Throw your scissors away and put your new Grooming Kit to the test. We guarantee precise, professional results or Philips Norelco will refund you the full purchase price as long as the request is received within 45 days of purchase.

To Charge/Recharge

- ▶ Fully charge Groomer before using for the first time or after non-use for a long period of time.
- ▶ Charging, recharging or using Groomer at temperatures below 40°F or higher than 95°F adversely affects lifespan of the battery.
- Be certain Groomer is OFF.
- 2 Connect appliance plug directly into the Groomer. Plug adapter into any 120VAC outlet (Fig. 1). Use only the cord provided.
- 3 The charging light on the adapter will light to indicate the Groomer is charging.
- It will take approximately 10 hours to fully charge the Groomer for a cordless trimming time of up to 35 minutes.
- You can charge the Groomer for 16 hours for a cordless trimming time up to 45 minutes.
- The charging light does not turn OFF after Groomer is fully charged.
- 4 Disconnect the cord and unplug from electrical outlet.

Optimize the working life of the battery

- After the Groomer has been charged for the first time, do not recharge the Groomer between grooming sessions. Continue using it until the battery is completely empty.
- Do not charge for more than 24 hours.
- Do not keep cord permanently plugged in.
- Discharge/run down the battery completely twice a year by letting the motor run until it
- If the Groomer hasn't been used for a long period of time, it must be recharged for a full 10 hours.

Cordless Trimming

- Charge according to directions. Unplug Groomer from outlet and remove cord.
- 2 Slide ON/OFF switch ON to begin trimming.
- 3 When finished, turn Groomer OFF.

Hair Clipping (QG3331 only)

- Use this Groomer for its intended household use as described in this manual.
- Make sure that the Groomer is fully charged before you start clipping. This Groomer will not operate while cord is connected to electrical outlet.
- Defore you start clipping, make sure that the head of the person whose hair you are cutting is at the same level as your chest so that all parts of his/her head are clearly visible and within easy reach.
- Make sure hair is clean and dry.
- Defore you begin, comb the hair in the direction of growth (Fig. 2).
- ▶ To achieve optimal clipping results, always move the appliance slowly through the hair against the direction of hair growth.

Do not move the Groomer too fast. Make smooth and gentle movements.

Clipping with hair clipper comb

- 1 Put the beard trimmer on Groomer handle (1) and turn clockwise (2) to lock in place (Fig. 3).
- 2 Slide the hair clipping comb into the guiding grooves on both sides of Groomer handle (Fig. 4).
- 3 Press the Hair Length Setting Selector (1) and slide the comb to the desired hair length setting (2) (Fig. 5).

The hair clipping comb cuts hair to a length of 1/8 - 25/32 in. (3-20mm).

4 The setting selected will appear on the back of the Groomer. When you are clipping for the first time, start

at the maximum clipping length setting (#20) to familiarize yourself with the appliance and prevent accidentally trimming hairs too short. As you become familiar with the settings, adjust the Hair

- Length Setting Selector to desired trimming length. Selector will 'click' into position at each setting.
- 5 Switch the Groomer ON (Fig. 6). 6 Make sure that the flat part of the comb is
- always in full contact with the scalp to obtain an even result (Fig. 7).
- 7 Move the appliance slowly over the crown from different directions to achieve an even result (Fig. 8).
- 8 Always move the appliance against the direction of hair growth. Press lightly.
- Make overlapping passes over the head to
- ensure that all hair that should be cut has been cut. Turn the Groomer off and remove the hair
- out hair that has accumulated. ▶ REMEMBER: You must reset the hair length selector back to your desired setting every time you replace the hair trimmer comb on the

appliance.

TIP: Write down the settings you have used to create

Use the Groomer without a comb to clip hair very close to the skin (3/64in./1mm) or to contour the neckline and area around the ears.

1 Remove the hair comb by pressing the Hair Length Setting Selector (1) and slide the comb upwards (2). Pull comb off Groomer (Fig. 9).

Be careful when you are clipping without comb attachment as when the Clipper is turned on it

- will remove every hair it touches. 2 To contour the hairline around the ears, comb the hair ends over the ears.
- 3 Tilt the Groomer in such a way that only
- one edge of the cutter blades touches the hair ends when you shape the contours around the ears (Fig. 10).
 Only cut the hair ends. The hairline should be

close to the ear.

- 4 To contour the nape of the neck or sideburns, turn the Groomer and hold it with the cutter blades pointing downwards (Fig. 11).
- 5 Move the Groomer slowly and smoothly following the natural hairline. Beard and Stubble Trimming

with a fine comb before you start trimming. If you are trimming for the first time, be

careful. Do not move the Groomer too fast. Make smooth and gentle movements.

Always comb your beard and/or moustache

After trimming, residual hair length can vary depending on hair type.

Use the beard comb to trim your beard and moustache to different lengths.

Beard Trimming With Beard Comb

- Trimming is easier when the skin and hair are dry. The hair length settings are indicated on the
- Groomer. The settings correspond to the remaining hair length after trimming. The beard trimming comb cuts hair to a length
- of 3/64 23/32 in. (1-18 mm). 1 Put the beard trimmer on Groomer handle (1) and turn clockwise (2) to lock in place (Fig. 3).
- 2 Slide the beard comb into the guiding grooves of the Groomer (Fig. 12).
- 3 Press the setting selector (1) and slide the comb to the desired hair length setting (2) (Fig. 13).
- If you are trimming for the first time, start by using the maximum trimming length setting of 23/32 in. (18mm) to prevent accidentally
- trimming hairs too short. As you become familiar with the settings, adjust the comb to desired trimming setting.
- 5 To trim in the most effective way, move the

Removing single, unwanted hairs

- 2 Remove the comb from the Groomer handle.
- 3 Switch the Groomer ON.
- 4 Make well-controlled movements. Touch the hair/skin lightly with the Groomer.
 - Stubble Trimming With Stubble Comb

Use the stubble comb to trim your stubble to different lengths.

The trimming comb cuts hair to a length of 3/64 - 15/32 in. (1-12 mm).

The hair length settings are indicated on the Groomer. The settings correspond to the remaining hair length after trimming.

- 1 Put the trimmer on Groomer handle (1) and turn clockwise (2) to lock into place (Fig. 3).
- 2 Slide the stubble comb into the guiding grooves of the Groomer (Fig. 14).

- 2 For best results, move the precision trimmer against the direction of hair growth making sure it is in full contact with the skin (Fig. 17). 3 Make careful and controlled movements with
- the precision trimmer (Fig. 18). Using Nose/Ear Hair Trimmer

Be certain the Groomer is in the OFF position.

- 2 Remove the trimmer by turning counterclockwise and then pull off the handle.
- 3 Put the nose/ear hair trimmer on the Groomer handle (1) and turn clockwise to lock into place (2) (Fig. 19).

Trimming Nose Hair Make sure nasal passages are clean.

- 1 Switch the Groomer ON and insert the tip of the attachment into one nostril (Fig. 20).
- CAUTION: Do Not insert the tip more than 3/16 in./5mm into your nostril.
- 2 Slowly move the tip in and out while turning it around at the same time in order to
- remove unwanted hair. For best results, make sure the side of the tip is firm against skin. This will reduce the tickling effect that can occur during trimming of nose hair. 3 Turn off Groomer. Rinse attachment clean

Trimming Ear Hair

after each use.

- Clean outer area of ear and ear canal. Make sure it is free of wax. Nose/ear hair trimmer should be on the
- Groomer.

NOTE: Since all hairs do not grow in the same direction, you may want to try different trimming

- Switch the Groomer ON and move the tip softly around the edge of ear to remove hairs extending beyond the outer ear (Fig. 21).
- Carefully insert the tip into outer ear canal (Fig. 22).

CAUTION: Do not insert the tip further than 3/16 in./5mm into the ear as this could cause damage to the eardrum.

3 Turn off Groomer. Rinse attachment clean after each use.

Cleaning

- ▶ Clean the attachments after each use.
- Always switch Groomer OFF, unplug and remove power supply cord from Groomer before cleaning.
- Do not use compressed air, abrasive cleaning agents, scourers or aggressive liquids such as alcohol, gasoline or acetone to clean the Groomer and attachments.
- Never clean, replace or remove Groomer attachments with motor ON.
- Do not apply pressure to cutters.
- Do not touch cutters with hard objects as this may damage them.

During Use:

If cut hairs have accumulated in the comb area, remove hairs by shaking, blowing or using cleaning brush provided. Remember to adjust the trimming length back to your selected setting when you replace the comb on Groomer.

After Each Use:

- Make sure the Groomer is switched OFF and disconnected from the electrical outlet.
- 2 Remove any comb or attachment.
- Blow and/or shake out any hair that may have accumulated in the comb or attachment.
- 4 Clean the handle, combs and attachments under lukewarm water or with the supplied cleaning brush.

Allow to air dry thoroughly.

5 Place the attachment back on the Groomer handle.

Storage

- Be sure Groomer is turned OFF. Remove cord from outlet and Groomer before storing in a safe, dry location where it will not be crushed, banged, or subject to damage.
- Do not wrap cord around Groomer when storing.

- Unplug electrical cord from outlet and Groomer before dismantling Groomer.
- 2 Allow the Groomer to run until the batteries are completely empty/depleted. Turn Groomer off.
- 3 Remove any comb and/or attachment from Groomer
- 4 Remove the On/Off switch of the appliance with a screwdriver.
- **5** Remove the front panel of the appliance with a screwdriver.
- 6 To pull out the inner, apply a tilting force in the indicated hole with a screwdriver. Pull upward on the top cover (Fig. 24).

7 Separate the inner and the tube (Fig. 25).

- 10 Cut the wires to separate the rechargeable battery from Groomer.
