

YOUR SAFETY

- Be sure to read and understand your Owner's Manual prior to operating your new Hyundai water pump. Failure to do so may result in personal injury and/or equipment damage.
- Familiarize yourself with your Hyundai water pump and all of the controls and how to operate them – you must know how to shut off your water pump in an emergency situation.
- Safety is very important when operating a water pump – be sure to use your best judgment when operating or maintaining your Hyundai water pump.
- Never permit anyone to operate your water pump without proper instruction – keep out of reach of children, and when in use, keep a safe distance from children and pets.
- Always operate your Hyundai water pump on a level surface; operating on any other surface may result in accidents and/or equipment damage potentially due to fuel spillage.
- Never pump flammable or corrosive material such as gasoline or acid.
- Keep your water pump at least 3 feet away from building walls and other equipment during operation. This is to prevent fire hazards and to provide adequate ventilation to your pumps engine.
- In the case of re-fueling, be sure the engine is stopped and that you are in a well-ventilated area. Do not smoke or allow flames or sparks to be in the area where the engine is being re-fueled or where the gasoline is being stored.
- Never overfill the fuel tank. Once the tank is full, replace the tank cap and ensure it is closed properly and securely.
- Be very careful not to spill fuel when re-fueling. If any fuel is spilled be sure the area is dry before starting the engine – spilled fuel may ignite and cause serious injury and/or damage.
- Exhaust from your water pump contains poisonous carbon monoxide gas – exposure to this gas can cause serious injury, loss of consciousness, and may in some cases, lead to death.
- After using the pump, and before storing it indoors, be careful not to touch the muffler as it becomes very hot during operation; touching it can lead to severe burns – let the engine completely cool before storing it.

YOUR WATER PUMP

- Read and fully understand your owner's manual prior to operating your Hyundai water pump – failure to do so could result in personal injury or equipment damage.
- Before each use, inspect your water pump in order to prevent accidents and/or equipment damage.
- Do not modify your water pump in any way.
- To ensure longevity of your water pump never pump sea water, muddy water, or chemical solutions – these liquids can cause corrosion which can greatly affect the functioning of your water pump.
- It is illegal in some areas to operate an engine without a spark arrester – you must check the local laws and regulations before operating your water pump. In the case of it being illegal to operate without a spark arrester, a spark arrester is available as an optional part.
- If maintenance is required, be sure to shut off the engine. Always seek professional help if you are unsure as to how to fix the problem.
